

# <u>SHAPE YOUR DAY, MONTH AND CONSEQUENTLY YOUR YEARS</u>



May the Lord grant you understanding of this prayer journal as you pray, consequent upon which there will be changes in your life or your prayer group or Family, Church, Nation, and Continent. <u>What is presented are not</u> Jewish Dates or the Jewish calendar but what the LORD instituted which we all see manifested in the movement of the Moon every month. The enemy has always manipulated these bodies for which believers are just becoming aware. This season is also a special edition of revelation which brings a new breath of fresh air without adding to the word of God but confirms it and makes our faith stronger.

#### You may wish to pray in two ways:-

- 1. You can pray using the whole journal to pray into the womb of time according to the authority level granted to you by your appointment in the Lord. Expect the prophetic germination [as you saturate the ground and the womb of time with God's ordination] to happen. In any case ensure your seed remains in the ground as investment for the coming year. Determine, and command what this month should deliver to you and what it should not and must Not.
- 2. You can also use this daily for your prayers AND DEVOTION to prevail at the gate of each day, especially on critical days of intense warfare in the heavens. Remember that the day starts from 6pm for the next 24 hours. If you are in Britain for instance the time will be early hours of the next day in Hong Kong @ your 6pm.
- 3. This document may seem lengthy, but it shows the effort that was generated in prayer. You can keep it and save it for use in a good way.

Pray that your prophetic faculties will be on the rise and be enlarged and sharp...<u>visions;</u> dreams; interpreting symbols; applying parables; riddles; revelation and predictions; accurate delivery of words of wisdom and words of knowledge; intercessions; interaction with heaven etc.. Divine decrees to cause the future and many other such faculties.

Ignorance of what every month holds for you, your family, community, nation, the church and the continent at large has caused many to perish, miss out or not fully access what God has in store for them.

Understanding the heavens and what they signify every month is another very key aspect as we enter this new level of our assignments among the nations. While the kingdom of darkness has used astrology, prognostications, and all manner of demonic methods to control the activities on earth using the heavens, the church continues in ignorance. They have even employed materialism to blind believers in Jesus Christ, whereas <u>all things are yours</u>

We thank God for the many people whom He is raising in different parts of the world to understand what the heavens hold for us every month. As you seek deeper understanding, the Holy Spirit will guide you into greater revelations. Amen.

# **BREAKING BLOODLINE POVERTY** AND ENABLING THE FUTURE.

#### (WE MUST NOT WAIT FOR GOVERNMENTS FOREVER)

"For he shall stand at the right hand of the poor, to save [him] from those that condemn his soul." "For he shall deliver the needy when he crieth; the poor also, and [him] that hath no helper. He shall spare the poor and needy and shall save the souls of the needy. He shall redeem their soul from deceit and violence: and precious shall their blood be in his sight" (Psalm 109:31; 72:12-14)

#### Introduction

It has become critical that we turn the tide and understand the current situation around us. God has promised to open our eye practically and he is doing so from the above scriptures. God stands at the right hand of the poor. The poor in spirit are those that come to the gospel. We have a specific strategy of outreach and be able to document it.

Our approach in the mission's field has been long-term to "*bring a future and hope*"-Jere 29:11. We do not desire that people would live with poverty forever. We desire to move people forward in faith and meet both real and perceived needs. *Our case is not a case where we want to bring intervention or mitigation and alleviation to the condition*. <u>We want to bring wholeness with hope and a future.</u> Intervention may bring poverty back while mitigation and alleviation may bring dependency, ingratitude, and a feeling of entitlement among those who benefit. <u>This has been the experience of field workers. Sometimes recipients develop an attitude to "wait till the next help comes".</u>

Bloodline poverty is the worst form of poverty. It is an oppressor when it runs through the family line. Children in such families learn to live off handouts from their already poor parents and adjust their expectations and ways of life to survive living with poverty. Young men and women adopt strange coping mechanisms in such a context. A young man in a poor neighbourhood justifies substance abuse with the explanation that it stops him from feeling hungry. We must also remember to break spiritual altars of poverty built in families . Those deities must be confronted and defeated.

#### Marks of generational poverty include the following: -

1. Children born into homes or families where they inherit no assets from their parents. Instead, they inherit liabilities. They take up responsibilities for their parents who had no savings no retirement benefits and no social welfare packages. They are laden with the care of their siblings, in some cases, nephews and nieces. This narrative passes on from one generation to another. Often, this becomes systemic or cultural where parents, once they have male children, boast of having given birth to those who will take over their responsibilities. It is worse when there are persons with disabilities in the family.

- 2. Children are born into homes or families with no role model of a successful person.
- 3. Children are born into families where parents have not modelled rejection of and freedom from dependency.
- 4. Children are born into homes or families that have adjusted and adapted their ways of life to live with poverty.
- 5. Subcultures that are non-competitive, with no structures for recognitions or rewards like those who live downtown.
- 6. A culture that practices gender inequality like the exclusion of the girl child from education and development, and in some cases, these are ruled out on matters of inheritance.
- 7. In some cultures families are ranked and the class you fall into in that society, determines the opportunities you have access to depending on the family you happened to be born into.

We may have well formed strategic house churches, and have prayed warfare prayers, and are helping families. What we have not done is to deal with bloodline poverty on a sustainable way. Such a strategy aims at reaching the spirit, soul, and body. The focus should be on families and communities and not just persons. The poor we will always have with us, implying that poverty as a state in life may not cease for everyone on this side of existence but those we serve (in Jesus Christ) must have hope that they can rise out of living with poverty and that their children will have better lives. Psalm 72 described the then immediate reign of David but was prophetic of the reign of Jesus and how he will deal with matters of justice for the poor and oppressed.

#### Defend the oppressed among the people.

Society is very oppressive to the vulnerable who have no voice, no muscles (no means of production), and no bargaining power. They are unnoticed and are invisible in our society. We must notice them and help bring them and their issues to people, to governments, the authorities and especially Christians and other church groups in their neighbourhoods. We must stir people's hearts to understand them and relate with them in righteousness and justice. We must reach out to them in their neighbourhoods, in the open slum markets and roadsides, in the construction sites, sand and stone quarries, where they eke out a hard living (Psalm 12:5, The Message, Proverbs 13:23, NIV84). *He will deliver the children of the poor.* Our focus on bringing help to the vulnerable in society must be generational. We must think of their children and their children's children. This is the nature of the work of God, His love and compassion. It is always generational. The Abrahamic covenant was generational. We must help them in ways that open doors for escape from poverty for their children.

For that to happen, our help to poor families must go beyond interventions as need requires or arises. We should aim to help the parents earn a decent income and to *model fruitful* work for their children. This gives them respect before their children and gives their children confidence and security. We can help them acquire new skills or start income-generating businesses.

#### A Foundation with Holistic Growth and Development.

The children need a good start, a foundation with holistic growth and development that will transform them and make them agents of transformation for their families and subculture,

people groups, and the larger society. We are engaging in the education of the children, by providing fees, education materials as well as extra reading and writing classes. We plan to help the children to acquire IT skills. We help the children embrace the fear of God, love for people, patriotism, heroism, character, and excellence. Plans include training them in life skills, success skills, and creativity as we go. "... crush the oppressor" We can defeat generational poverty and lay a foundation for a future. We can develop workable plans for this to happen. We discard superstitions, blaming, shaming the poor, and bind the powers of poverty. We engage generational poverty with grace and truth, to overcome it. Such freedom does not come by wishing and prayer alone but by untying the yoke of bondage, freeing people from ignorance through the impartation of knowledge, unlearning former ways of living and learning new ways of living, and inspiring hope for the future (2 Pet.1:3 – 11). We can raise a new generation who will not be like their fathers, Psa.78:1 - 8. We can change the narrative (Isa. 29:17-21). We can obliterate the shame of generational poverty from families and give the gospel a sharp cutting edge among the poor. Isa.29:22–24. There are practical ways we have used but we have to document them and make it better for records, accountability, patterns and enable us repeat success. There are ways we can do these...

#### 1. Primary and High School education assistance

The need for basic education in the life of every child cannot be over-emphasized. It equips the child with the ability to read, write, think, and solve basic problems. We already have children of staff or members of the congregation who have benefitted from the ministry of our churches. We have to be open to pursue part-time, online, continuing education for those who have entry-point low-income jobs. Such could be used to help them prepare to sit the High School examinations, Matriculation Examinations, or obtain a post-High School Diploma or Certificate.

#### 2. Vocational/Skill Acquisition Support. Trainings or Skills we can support: -

- i. Computer/IT skill training for slum kids who finish High School to help them find jobs
- ii. Training for retail shop assistants, shop salespeople
- iii. Training for restaurant workers and other public food processing workers.
- iv. Confectionery, Baking, Cooking and Soap making
- v. Domestic Work Home/house Care, Nanny work
- vi. Textiles and fashion design
- vii. Interior decoration and Landscaping
- viii. Smartphones and computers hardware repair
- ix. Electricity generators maintenance.
- x. Automobile maintenance
- xi. Metal work fabrication, welding, forging
- xii. Woodworks

#### 3. Income-Generation and Small-scale businesses

Each suggestion or idea that comes for consideration will be evaluated on its merits. It must be viable, profitable, and competitive with a growing market. E.g

- i. Food Vending
- ii. POS business
- iii. Commercial Tricycles
- iv. Retailing varieties of stuff, including raw food, drinks, women's make-up.

<u>*Context.*</u> The context must be sated with spiritual growth, Basic discipleship, character development and training in stewardship. Where this cannot happen within the training environment, we will seek to provide a parallel program to cover these.

The above can be used and indeed improve in several ways.

- 1. We can use this budget as a faith project for vigorous prayers.
- 2. We use these budgets to launch a vigorous fund-raising campaign to serve people.
- 3. We design a format for other areas of work in the church or missions' field in the same way.
- 4. The administrative charges are taken out of any amount we receive through the office before it is applied.
- 5. It may be helpful to ask donors to work that into what they want to give towards supporting a particular project.
- 6. The local running service include-transportation, bank charges, and government taxes on transactions (eg vat) and other local service charges.
- 7. Develop a sample copy for the coming Business workshop/Women empowerment for your church on collective community or family bases.

8. Remember that our context is training and empowerment. We can do prayer war over concrete plans and these attempts will, by God's grace to lead out from a bloodline of poverty.


The current programs run by the FMI in the mission fields range from: -

- 9. Community development-provision of boreholes, school fees assistance to extremely poor children, clinics, advocacy

- A. Pray that GOD will teach your hands to war and your fingers to do battle so you can break the steel bows of the witches, wizards, sorcerers, necromancers, diviners, monthly prognosticators, astrologers, traffickers of familiar spirits and the queen of heaven (Ps 18:34; Ps 144:1)
- B. For any army to win a war, they will ensure their air-force is in place. Whether it is simple Calvary in ancient times, or soldiers positioned on the city walls, or on high hills or elevated places, these have the best view of the battle. For you to overcome the enemy in this spring season, ensure that the heavens are in agreement with you. Speak to the heavens over the month and ask them to declare the glory of Jehovah. Command the sun, moon, stars and every heavenly being to do Jehovah's bidding, and to do that which they were created for to give Him pleasure (Ps 19:1-2, Rev 4:11)
- C. Galatians 3.13-14 Jesus PAID IT ALL for every single territory and every single individual more than 2000 years ago before they were nations and before they even sinned or did anything good or bad. Appropriate the finished work of the Cross of Calvary over each territory and its people wherever they may be. Their deliverance was already sorted out. Proclaim this truth over the lies of the enemy
- D. These people groups have the opportunity to enter into the blessing of redemption. Salvation is their blood-bought right. The enemy has deceived the Ecclesia into a position of weakness and hopelessness. Pray that the church will arise triumphant in this season and recognize her powerful and authoritative role to steer the nation into the path of redemptive purpose at the place of prayer.
- E. Pray against idolatrous festivals that fall in February. These festivals of men have become cause for untold damage to relationships and a greater sense of loneliness for others. It is a season where in nations like Namibia, they record the highest number of suicides. When people feel abandoned or rejected because they have not been remembered with "gifts", there is a sense of guilt when relatives, friends or colleagues cannot afford to spend lavishly or give "time off" to employees during these festivals. Marriages have experienced breakdown because at Christmas or Easter certain expectations were not met in terms of time spent with loved ones, gifts and holidays given to significant others, illicit affairs exposed, sickness even death from overindulgence and reckless abandon in morals and general behavior. Yet funny enough, you never hear of such damage to relationships because of the 7 real Feasts of Jehovah. Ask Jehovah

to deliver you and kingdom citizens at large from the traps of the enemy wrapped up in these various celebrations.

- F. Pray for strong Christian families.
- G. Pray for our ministry partners for financial provision.
- H. Pray for Christian spouses for our children and for our children to extend the kingdom.
- I. Pray that the leaders of the nations would have a Damascus experience.
- J. Pray for our children who are disappointed with the Body of Christ and sees it as hypocritical. that they will build a personal relationship with Jesus.
- K. Pray for the financial resources that we need to advance the work of the Kingdom in the nations.

#### Growth and Decline


Over the past century, Christianity witnessed its most marked growth in Sub-Saharan Africa and its most marked decline in the Middle East, North Africa, and Western Europe.




# <u>Unreached People by Region- Source: The Joshua Project, 2023</u> Definition

Unreached people groups are those who lack an indigenous church capable of evangelizing their own people. People groups are distinct social groups where shared language and cultural practices create communal belonging.


## Missionary Challenge




Rise of Evangelicals and Pentecostals- Source: World Christian Encyclopaedia pgs. 25-26, 2020; M = Millions

## PROPHETIC PRAYER FOR THE MONTH OF JUNE 2024

David and others prophesied often in the Psalms about the whole earth experiencing salvation. These were prophecies about the kingdom. David, who was a king, prophesied often about the greater kingdom of his Seed, Christ, the Messiah. Some of those prophecies in the Book of Psalms are shown below:

- "You are My Son ... I will give You the nations for Your inheritance" (Ps. 2:7-8).
- "All the families of the nations shall worship before You" (Ps. 22:27).
- "The earth is the LORD'S" (Ps. 24:1).
- "According to Your name, O God, so is Your praise to the ends of the earth" (Ps. 48:10).
- "You who are the confidence of all the ends of the earth" (Ps. 65:5).
- "All nations whom You have made shall come and worship before you, O Lord" (Ps. 86:10).

• "The nations shall fear the name of the LORD, and all the kings of the earth Your glory" (*Ps. 102:15*).

• "Be exalted, O God, above the heavens, and Your glory above all the earth" (Ps. 108:5).

The vision of the prophets was always global. The kingdom would not be limited to Israel but would encompass all nations. The scribes and teachers understood this but did not understand how it would be accomplished. It would come through the death of the Messiah, the descent of the Holy Spirit and the preaching of the gospel.

When reading these scriptures there should be no doubt of the plan and purpose of God. This purpose comes through the church, the new-creation people, who will become a global phenomenon. The church could not be limited to Jerusalem. The Book of Acts is the story of the church and kingdom breaking out of the framework of the old covenant and breaking forth throughout the whole earth.

#### ...a strategy for loving the missionary family as well as the people groups, they serve

Adopt-A-Missionary is a mission strategy that has gained momentum in missions over the years. What makes this strategy different is its focus. Historically, churches have focused on countries, and mission agencies have focused their attention on people groups. Adopt-A-Missionary focuses *on missionary families, or what we can call message bearers*.

For 5 years, my wife (of blessed memory) and I served as missionary representatives to the Kenyan peoples of East Africa. We divided the nation of Kenya into 6. Working with the missionary on ground we had a plan to evangelise the nation. We raised teams of two by two from Nigeria and planted 6 churches throughout the country. In the last 29 years + the FMI missionary teams have been helped by God to open the gospel among 40 unreached people groups. Our FMC churches faithfully prayed and the missionaries that we served with, and the church has supported them financially.

In 1990 for example, we were relocated to Kano with two major tribes- the Kanawas and Magusawas. We were led of the Lord to pay more attention to *tribal missions in 1993, where the gospel has never been heard while maintaining a church base.* Thankfully, our churches have continued to pray for and support the mission's effort with this strategic ministry.

#### **ADOPT-A-Missionary Defined**

What then does it mean to Adopt-A-missionary? It means committing yourself as an individual, fellowship group, local congregation, denomination, or mission agency to pray for and commit resources to win souls, establish believers, administrate the work within a specific people group through a missionary family or families. This commitment is continued until the believers in that people group can reach the rest of their people without outside (cross-cultural) assistance.

We are agents of God praying, giving, and serving to see an adopted family reach out to bring sinners into God's family. This is the true meaning of Adopting a missionary family. One day this will be accomplished, and every tribe, tongue, people, and nation will give glory to God around His throne (Rev. 5:9).

#### **Adopt a Missionary Family**

Fullstature Missions International is committed to the work of missions and has developed a ministry to bring into focus the Great Commission (Matt 28:19-20) set forth by Christ and to support missionary families need. We ask that your family prayerfully consider adopting a missionary family to be a blessing and to be blessed. After you have made an adoption, we encourage you can send your missionary family an email to share about your family and to ask them to share with you. The FMI becomes a bridge to help people you may never know or meet. You can reach out to the missionary during Holidays, birthdays, or anniversaries or just at any time. Commit to lift your missionary up in prayer. (Phil 6)

It is also our desire to support more missionaries through our ministry budget than we currently can do. The missionaries we support currently are under-supported. In other words, the support we grant is not adequate. In most cases, we are nearly able (with Naira) to provide what will keep body and soul together leaving projects in the field undone. This is where you pause and do something.

It is our goal to ensure that every Missionary, supported through, (what we call) the General Fund which includes the "Faith Promise Offering" (FPO), are missionaries we, as a ministry want to support.

The money these Missionaries receive is totally dependent on what is given by the individual or families who have adopted them.

**Example:** Missionary "Felix" may have two families in First Baptist Church which chose to adopt him. They do so for a combined support of \$200 per month, one for \$75 per month and one for \$125 per month. Should the family who chose to support Missionary "Felix" for \$125 per month be unable to do so for any reason, Missionary "Felix" would only receive \$75 for that month. There will be a "shortfall" and the family who was unable to give what they had purposed to give would not be contacted and asked, "Where is your contribution".

If you have a desire to support a Missionary, please feel free to fill out a "Adopt-A-Missionary Request Form" and return it to our ministry office.

#### **Build a Relationship**

Develop a relationship with your adopted missionary family. Learn about their ministry and their ups and downs so that you know when to Praise God with them and when to lift them up in prayer. Being a missionary can have some very hard times and there is great comfort when a missionary knows that God is always there and that there are people supporting them at every step.

#### **Faith Promise**

In addition to your commitment to get to know and pray for your adopted missionary, you may consider supporting your missionary financially. Among some of the greatest difficulties that missionaries face is having their financial needs met. Missionaries typically spend a significant amount of time raising monies to support their ministries which in turn reduces the amount of time out in the field.

• Ask Jehovah to forgive you where you have for one reason or another, ignored or rejected to recognize your day of birth.

• Thank Jehovah for the day of your conception. (Psa 139:13)

• Thank Jehovah that when He thought of you, he already thought of your entire life. Thank Him that He did not leave anything to chance. (Isa 49:1)



# PERSONAL PRIESTHOOD

#### SATURDAY, JUNE 1, 2024 Scripture: Exodus 19:5-8

The priesthood stands on a platform of covenant. I pray that your eye of understanding will open so that you understand that the priesthood stands on the platform of covenant. All the benefits of the priesthood can be fully realize when we recognize the reason it stands on a platform of covenant. The covenantal platform extended to make the priesthood possible was not man's idea. This concept originated with God. Giving man a covenant was God's idea. God deemed covenant necessary so we might function in the priesthood.

What does that mean for us who may attempt to function in the office of a priest without fully understanding the power of covenant? Our priestly function CAN be diminished proportionally to the degree we do not fully appreciate the magnitude of what covenant affords. What then can a priest do from a platform of covenant? Does covenant provide the confidence to stand before the Lord boldly?

#### SUNDAY, JUNE 2, 2024 Scripture: Genesis 15:1-8

In Genesis 15:1-8 Abram and God are having a discussion. The Lord initiates this dialogue with Abram via the form of a vision saying, "Do not be afraid, Abram. I am your shield, your exceedingly great reward." Abram responds to God's initiative by commenting on his current childless state and the fact that the promise of a child has not yet come to pass, leaving him stuck according to custom, with the heir of his house being his chief steward; Eliezer of Damascus. Eliezer is not even Jewish. Abram continues his complaint being very graphic with the Lord over this issue. God's response is essentially; "It will be as I told you before. You will have an heir from your own body." But the Lord adds an aid to faith in verse 5, which is the visual conceptualization component of the promise by telling Abram to look to heaven and count the stars. Notice how God turned a promise into imagination (pictures) Abram dialogued with God in MEDITATION to ground CONVICTION. No one can count all the stars – there

are too many of them. Abram believed the Lord concerning the promise. There was an additional purpose God brought Abram out of Ur of the Chaldeans; to inherit the land. Abram still obviously in a place of mild indecision cries out one more time and says to God, "Lord God, how shall I know that I will inherit it?" The "...how shall I know..." is a heart-cry demand, "I need a firm foundation of cement to stand on in believing You are, in fact, going to bring this promise to pass." You can almost sense Abram's feelings, "It's been a promise for a long time, and a promise that doesn't materialize isn't worth much. All I have is a promise, and I've been carrying it around for over a decade. I need more." Abram is demanding to know that he knows what God has promised He will perform. When we understand what Abram's heart-cry produced - we understand the foundational platform of covenant. The process we just read in the preceding lines is the way to bring the unseen into the seen realm.

#### MONDAY, JUNE 3, 2024 Scripture: Genesis 15:9-21

In this process, God responds to Abram's cry, "...how shall I know?" by bringing something familiar in the culture called blood covenant. God instructs Abram to bring a "...three-year-old heifer, a three-year-old goat, a three-year-old ram, a turtledove, and a young pigeon." Abram must split every thing down the middle and protect it as he waits on the Lord. God's response to Abram goes right back to the initial question, "...how shall I know?" God says, "Know certainly that your descendants will be strangers in a land that is not theirs, and will serve them, and they will afflict them four hundred years. And also the nation whom they serve I will judge; afterward they shall come out with great possessions. Now as for you, you shall go to your fathers in peace; you shall be buried at a good old age. But in the fourth generation they shall return here, for the iniquity of the Amorites is not yet complete." God made a covenant with Abram, and in that covenant was the guarantee that what He had promised He would surely bring to pass. Now Abram has something firm and foundational to stand on. He can stand on the cement of covenant. He can stand knowing full well what God promised He has now covenantally obligated Himself to produce!

#### TUESDAY, JUNE 4, 2024 Scripture: Genesis 15:10; Jeremiah 34:15-20

One of the things we want to ask ourselves is why is it important to cut the animals in two and to pass between the pieces? The answer to that appears in Jeremiah 34:15-20 as once again they make a covenant with God as a nation and walk through the pieces. We culturally understand that in making blood covenants they would stand between the pieces, profess their unity and what they were going to do for each other. They would also repeat curses, if they were ever to break the covenant, God would do so to them and more in making them exactly like the sacrificed animals – split in two. So when God initiated a blood covenant in answer to Abram's question, Abram knew God was obligating Himself to bring to pass the promise in such a way as to establish a platform he could stand on functioning in full assurance of faith. When Abram said, "…how shall I know…" God answered and Abram from that point on had no excuse – he knew! Do not take the Blood of Jesus lightly!

#### WEDNESDAY, JUNE 5, 2024 Scripture: First Samuel 18:1-4

We continually begin to see the depth of the covenant in the different places where Scripture comments on people entering such a strong and powerful agreement! In the relationship of

Jonathan and David they entered into a blood covenant. We are told they made a covenant, and their souls were knit together. We find in verse 4 of First Samuel 18, "And Jonathan took off the robe that was on him and gave it to David, with his armor, even to his sword and his bow and his belt." When two people made covenant, one of the provisions was that when either one of the participants went to war the other one was obligated with his strength and weaponry to come to the aid of the one attacked. <u>Our covenant gives us access to God to settle, change, or otherwise turn the events of warfare that arise in our lives.</u> We see it was a vital part of the outworking of covenant, not only between Jonathan and David, but also between Abraham and Lot. Abraham went to war when Lot was attacked. Covenant covered the broad spectrum of human need and when God offers man covenant we know it is very much to our benefit. Are we aware of all the provision belonging to us in covenant?

Covenant gives you access as a son of God to understand the ordinances of heaven. If you have any doubt why is that even the children of Adam are going to the moon and understand the movement of the heavenly bodies and going on tour in space?

DECLARE YOU ARE NOT UNDER THE GOVERNMENT OF THE SUN, THE MOON AND THE STARS. PROCLAIM THAT YOU HAVE THROUGH CHRIST ATTAINED AND acquired GOD's ordained knowledge for the heavens, AND you proceed to set up their dominion here on earth (Job 38:31-33). <u>The sun shall not smite thee by day, nor the moon by</u> <u>night (Ps 121:6)</u>. But I am the LORD thy God, that divided the sea, whose waves roared: The LORD of hosts is his name. And I have put my words in thy mouth, and I have covered thee in the shadow of mine hand, that I may plant the heavens, and lay the foundations of the earth, and say unto Zion, Thou art my people. (Isaiah 51:15-16).

For any army to win a war, they will ensure their air-force is in place. Whether it is simple Calvary in ancient times, or soldiers positioned on the city walls, or on high hills or elevated places, these have the best view of the battle. For you to overcome the enemy in this spring season, ensure that the heavens are in agreement with you. Speak to the heavens over the month and ask them to declare the glory of Jehovah. Command the sun, moon, stars and every heavenly being to do Jehovah's bidding, and to do that which they were created for - to give Him pleasure (Ps 19:1-2, Rev 4:11)

GOD created the heavens and gave them their role in creation - to determine the times and seasons on earth (Gen 1:14-18). It is a must for every kingdom citizen to study and

understand the heavens and know our role as stewards of His estate toward them – not the Ungodly astrology, horoscope and other occult practices.

Once we acquire GOD's ordained knowledge for the heavens, we will be able to set up their dominion here on earth (Job 38:31-33). Remember that in Matthew 28:18-20 Jesus commissioned the fledgling Ecclesia with all the authority given to Him to go out into all nations and disciple them. This authority included that which is in heaven and on earth. It is our duty to answer in the affirmative, the question that Job was asked concerning the visible firmament in Job 38:31-33.

The New Moon will occur on JUNE 6, 2024 @ 12:37 UTC. The daily physical shape of the moon in the sky determines the difference between the sickles and the bows.

• Enter the gates of this month with thanksgiving for all that the LORD has allowed you to experience in the past season.

• Command the gates of that day to be lifted up unto the LORD for the King of glory to go in and for His purposes alone to be accomplished. Ps 24:7-10

• Declare the Shalom of the LORD at every gate of this new season. The gates of this season will be gates of righteousness and praise and the walls salvation. Wherever the man of peace shall be, the peace of Jehovah will rest upon them. Wherever there shall be a man of violence, they shall be judged in this strong season of judgement and retribution, Psalm 118:12, Isa 60:18-20, Rev 4:11

• Read Isa 33:22 and bring any area of justice e.g. court cases, family feuds, village disputes, and land or business disputes before the LORD. Remind yourself that beyond the human justice structures whether councils of elders, judges, or tribunals, He remains our Judge, our Lawgiver and our King and Isaiah reminds you that He will save you.

• There have been activities in the nations which begun a season of widespread judgement. It has resulted in generalized disorder, disorganization, imperfection, and disintegration in especially in the economic gate of society. After this, Jehovah will reshuffle, reorganize, restructure, rearrange, and reorder those gates to create an environment for them to align with His purposes, which have been planned for this season and favors kingdom citizens economically. Jer 29:11, Eccl 2.26.

• Pray Psalm 61-63. When you are overwhelmed, may the LORD be your Refuge. Pray this for the Ecclesia in the territory.

• Pray that in this season of judgement you will be a sharpened arrow which the LORD can shoot forth and you will land on target Psa 127:3-5

• Pray through Isaiah 28:5-6. If you will become an instrument of justice and judgement in this season, remember that it is the prerogative of the kings to deal with such matters. Ask for a kingly anointing to carry out this activity. Ask the LORD to be your glorious crown in your capacity as a kingly priest. Also ask the LORD to be the Spirit of Justice to you and to all kingdom citizens who sit in judgment and a source of strength as you turn the battle at the gates.

#### THURSDAY, JUNE 6, 2024 Scripture: Genesis 17:1-16

In Genesis 17, God comes to Abram and adds to the covenant. This time God begins to broaden the covenantal promise. He says, "And I will establish My covenant between Me and you and your descendants after you in their generations, for an everlasting covenant, to be God to you and your descendants after you." He goes on to tell Abram He will give him the land and it will go to his descendants, and that he must keep the covenant along with his descendants throughout their generations. He adds a sign of the covenant in the form of circumcision, which typifies the cutting away of flesh to fulfill God's preparational requirements. The covenant was God's guarantee that the promise would come to pass. Abram would soon stand on that covenant and demonstrate the power it would have for a priest who would be bold enough to use it. How can we ever do business with God unless we fully understand the power of the covenant, which has been given?

#### FRIDAY, JUNE 7, 2024 Scripture: Second Corinthians 8:1-15

Once again we see the power of the covenant moving forward to include every aspect of man's need. In Second Corinthians 8 we are told, "For you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though He was rich, yet for your sakes He became poor, that you through His poverty might become rich." The power of the covenant was extended even to the individual finances for the purpose of bringing God's will to pass in the earth. Financial covenant has been taught and made very controversial because the teaching of it lacked circumcision. People were allowed to use it for their own personal gain when the truth of the matter is, it was given by God for His purpose for world evangelization and to pay for the harvest of nations. To teach financial covenant without including the cross and dealing with the spirit of mammon is to offer unrestrained people that which will ultimately destroy them without the bridle of the cross. God's financial covenant is very real in Scripture to all those who are willing to pay the price to walk it out. He goes on to promise, in verses 12-15. God's covenant even includes financial provision for others as well as us.

#### SATURDAY, JUNE 8, 2024 Scripture: Genesis 21:22-32

Abraham and Abimelech make a covenant. They sit down, they speak to each other, they undoubtedly go through all the previous steps of covenant and Abram gives a gift as a sign that the well near where they enter covenant is one he has dug. Previous wells had been taken by Abimelech's people and Abraham wants to make sure this well that they worked so hard to create stays as a water source for his own flock. So at the end of their covenant they sit and enjoy a meal. We also see the foundational covenantal aspect of the Last Supper, or communion in Gen 14 of the exchange between Abraham and Melchizedek. Communion was the last act of establishing covenant. They would sit together, having fully agreed, and then finish their time together in fellowship over a communion meal. Most churches are familiar with the communion table and what it means. Do we see it as the final act of covenant? When we have communion, we are saying, "God, we receive Your covenant as a vital part of our life and being, and we are going to walk it out and the provisions of it declare that which is ours and what we can expect." It was true for Abraham and Melchizedek and it was true for Abraham and Abimelech – and it must be true for us today. If it's not, we're missing a major part of what God has provided. God has bound himself by the covenant of the blood of Jesus to save and to heal and to deliver.

#### SUNDAY, JUNE 9, 2024 Scripture: First Corinthians 11:23-34

First Corinthians 11 gives us both the blessing and the judgment of covenant, because it outlines both sides of what it means to walk in covenant. This, of course, is our communion

passage and we recognize the Early Church when they ate the bread and drank the cup was proclaiming the Lord's death till He comes. They proclaimed the life-style Jesus lived, and all HIS SACRIFICE in ALL what He had done.

By coming to the communion table - an act of communion, we're agreeing to the life-style, but we're also laying hold of all the covenantal promises. The warning of First Corinthians 11 is the warning of not defiling the covenant with our own selfishness, because when we do, three dimensions of judgment are initiated.

They're called 'weak', 'sick' and 'dead.' The warning of First Corinthians 11 is the warning of not taking the covenantal promises and attempting to embrace them specifically for our own purposes and for our own gain. To do that brings us into conflict. Many people have had so many problems and many prayer failures that they don't believe anything anymore. The truth of the matter is the covenantal promises are very real and very much ours. The issue then becomes one of what is your motivation and what is your heart? What is your purpose? Are you seeking God's covenant for your own personal gain or are you seeking it to apply it to God's end-time purpose in harvesting nations? The Scripture is clear. If we are going to walk in covenant and stand on that platform, we have to do it for God's purposes and not our own personal gain. Where do we stand with the covenant?

#### MONDAY, JUNE 10, 2024 Scripture: Romans 8:1-2

It doesn't take long to figure out why we need a covenant when we read Romans 8:1-2. The verses say, "There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit. For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made me free from the law of sin and death." The necessity of a covenant is because of the issue of sin, condemnation, and consequent spirit of death. The covenant lifts us above what knowing law produces or head knowledge produces – "death and condemnation". Covenant reaches down and pulls us out of the reality of our own personal failure and lets us stand on a platform of faith knowing God's redemption and blessing is greater than any of our mistakes. God's provision in the blood of Jesus lifts us way above our own personal shortcomings. Without understanding covenant, we do not have the full assurance of faith it takes to enter God's throne room -that is the place of prayer and do business with Him. Prayer business in the Throne Room many times requires a lot of legal procedure and protocol and negotiation. In that process we are standing on the platform the covenant guarantees. We need to learn our covenant and walk in it to be the priests that make a difference.

#### TUESDAY, JUNE 11, 2024 Scripture: Isaiah 14:11-15

A sense of history will settle many of our issues. In doing that we see stages of necessary growth basic to understanding how-to walk-in covenant. The issue of why we need our covenant is worth tracing because in the process we discover stages of necessary growth, each of which contributes tremendously toward full assurance of faith in the Throne Room.

Isaiah 14:11-15 declares the origin of our enemy. We know he was a worship leader created to lead the creation in worship to God until iniquity was found in him. Verses 12-14 describe the inner working of sin and give us a glimpse of the magnitude of our warfare. We are told, "For you have said in your heart: 'I will ascend into heaven, I will exalt my throne above the stars of God; I will also sit on the mount of the congregation On the farthest sides of the north; I will

ascend above the heights of the clouds, I will be like the Most High." Satan desired to be NUMBER ONE. THIS IS A SERIOUS REVELATION OF SATAN'S CHARACTER.

We find the five "I will's" that constitute the formation of Satan's character and nature. Rebellion is the foundation of his throne. We discover the full measure of what makes him our enemy in the determination to be like the Most High. Why do we need a covenant? Because of the transfer of lordship that took place in the Garden. We know Jesus came with the specific purpose of regaining that lordship, but in the process of following the Lord, a pattern emerges which sheds much light on what we face in spiritual resistance.

#### WEDNESDAY, JUNE 12, 2024 Scripture: Genesis 1:26-28

In Genesis, as the creation unfolds, GOD SO LOVED MAN AND WAS SO MINDFUL OF HIM BECAUSE MAN WAS IN GOD'S IMAGE AND LIKENESS/ God makes man in His own image and likeness and gives them, according to verse 26, "...dominion..." over all the creation with nothing excluded. God imparts creative ability to those bearing His image and likeness. Man's first act of dominion is finishing the creative process by naming the animals. Man accepts the charge, "fill the earth and subdue it." In Genesis 1 things are going well! Man is created, has been given dominion and all he has to do is exercise it. We could all have lived happily ever after. Dominion was gained in Genesis and dominion was lost in Genesis. We're in the process of working out the victory that has regained it! That's why we need to know the progressive foundation of our priesthood.

#### THURSDAY, JUNE 13, 2024 Scripture: Luke 4:1-8

Luke 4 tells us this, "Then the devil took Him up on a high mountain, showed Him all the kingdoms of the world in a moment of time. And the devil said to Him, 'All this authority I will give You, and their glory; for this has been delivered to me, and I give it to whomever I wish. Therefore, if you will worship before me, all will be yours.' And Jesus answered and said to him, 'Get behind Me, Satan! For it is written, You shall worship the Lord your God, and Him only you shall serve.'" Where did Satan get the authority, he claims in Luke chapter 4? He got it in Genesis 3 through Adam's failure to use his dominion when he yielded to temptation. Jesus came to regain the authority Adam lost and impart it to the Church through the Holy Spirit. Even in the Lord's Prayer we are praying God's authority will manifest in the earth just like it is in heaven.

- 1. There is no rebellion in heaven and no warfare against the will of God.
- 2. Resistance exists here in the earth and it's surrounding atmosphere.
- 3. So as the progression unfolds we find man is created, given dominion, and
- 4. Through rebellion loses that dominion so
- 5. The devil, attacks and kills the agent of deliverance Jesus.
- 6. The issue is dominion, who is ruler?
- 7. How are we doing with authority? Do we walk in what Jesus has purchased and transferred to believers? Do we exercise it? Or are we still discovering that God has specific assignments only we can fill?

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#### Crescents and Quarter Moons

When the moon is shaped like a C or its mirror image (Sickle), it is considered a crescent moon. The quarter moon is shaped like a D or its mirror image and considered to be a bow. The occult will use the bow shaped moon to shoot arrows of wickedness to the unsuspecting in order to draw unfair advantage in various areas of life. The occult uses the crescent moon as sickles (e.g. Hecate's sickle), for harvesting the gains of the ignorant and for demonic strength and fortification with intense enchantments.

- Proclaim Psalm 148 and Command all creation especially the crescent and Quarter moons to praise GOD as instructed in Psalm 19.
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This is also the time when they increase their enchantments, for strength and fortification

• For all those that handle the sickle at the time of harvest for unjust gains, pray that Jehovah will send His fishers to fish them out of their hideouts and hunters to hunt them for destruction Jere 16:16, Rev 14:14-20.

#### FRIDAY, JUNE 14, 2024 Scripture: Colossians 1:19-23

Colossians 1 is very clear in its proclamation of restoration. We are told, "For it pleased the Father that in Him all the fullness should dwell, and by Him to reconcile all things to Himself, by Him, whether things on earth or things in heaven, having made peace through the blood of His cross. And you, who once were alienated and enemies in your mind by wicked works, yet now He has reconciled in the body of His flesh through death, to present you holy, and blameless, and irreproachable in His sight – if indeed you continue in the faith, grounded and steadfast, and are not moved away from the hope of the gospel which you heard, which was preached to every creature under heaven, of which I, Paul, became a minister." The issue in the restoration is our ability to stand before the Throne "...holy, blameless and irreproachable in His sight....." We must endeavour to make what is written in Colossians become a reality so we can have the boldness to enter the Throne Room and do business on the platform of our covenant! How are we doing in the Throne Room? Do we know how to walk in there like we

belong in His presence? Do we walk in there, as those who know our authority is restored, blameless, irreproachable, and holy in His sight? <u>If not – we're not standing on the full measure of the platform God has ordained</u>. It's no wonder we're not having the impact the Lord intended for the Church. We'll never have it until we utilize the full measure of the covenant.

#### SATURDAY, JUNE 15, 2024 Scripture: Matthew 28:18, 19

In Matthew 28 we run into a very familiar passage called the "Great Commission." In it Jesus outlines the restoration of authority lost. He says, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." Authority has now been restored. It is restored to those who can receive it. Jesus suffered and died to make this authority freely available, but to wield it and exercised it, we need the full assurance of faith and communion in the Throne Room. We need such conviction and persuasion.

1. Communion in the Throne Room imparts the application of authority.

2. We must operate as a collective, with God, as dependent people.

3. We have to stay within the boundary of relationship God ordained for us.

4. Through personal communion, authority flows from the head into the body to accomplish eternal goals. (Not like Satan who want to be at the top of the mountains and be exalted for himself)

- 5. To find out where you stand, ask the following question:
- 6. Who is the application of authority I'm attempting to make going to benefit?
- 7. Is the application more personal or eternal?
- 8. Will it benefit only me?

#### SUNDAY, JUNE 16, 2024 Scripture: Hebrews 13:10-15

Hebrews 13 fully proclaims the victory Jesus obtained for us, as it translates to a platform for our priesthood. He says, "Therefore Jesus also, that He might sanctify the people with His own blood, suffered outside the gate. Therefore, let us go forth to Him, outside the camp, bearing His reproach. For here we have no continuing city, but we seek the one to come. Therefore, by Him let us continually offer the sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of our lips, giving thanks to His name." The boldness that comes with knowing our covenantal position - brings full assurance of faith! Do we have faith in the Throne Room? Are we standing on our covenant? Are we using our authority for someone other than ourselves?

#### MONDAY, JUNE 17, 2024 Scripture: Jonah 3:5-10

When it comes to the issue of saving or impacting a nation, Jonah has a message that fits right where we are today. The message of Jonah very clearly is that if we will pay the price and accept God's assignment, we can impact and turn a city or country. Once Jonah came to grips with the issue of his call and that God is a God of mercy he made that turn. Verses 5-10 of chapter 3 discuss the fruit of preaching to Nineveh. Nineveh turned and verse 10 says, "Then God saw their works, that they turned from their evil way; and God relented from the disaster that He had said He would bring upon them, and He did not do it." The Fruit of Jonah's ministry was the salvation of a city-state. Is it not possible that we, who have a better covenant based

on better promises, could see that fruit again in our generation? Let's trust the Lord to see Him turn a nation as we stand on our covenant.

#### TUESDAY, JUNE 18, 2024 Scripture: Jonah 4:1-5

The sad part of the story, in verses 1-5, is that Jonah becomes very very disheartened and discouraged and begins to flee because he sees the word he has given is heeded to the point that God's judgement is averted. Jonah is more concerned about his prophetic reputation than he is about the saving of the city; consequently, his response when there is no destruction is to flee – in anger and hostility. Jonah is angry because the word he proclaimed does not come to pass. Should we not accept the fruit of the application of our faith in a different way? The issue is not whether it comes to pass or whether it doesn't. It is much more – what did it accomplish in the hearts and lives of the people who heard it and what was their response. If there is a turning, then the proclamation was well worth the judgment. Jonah has to learn it the hard way and his story is written for our admonition upon whom the ends of the world have come. Are we willing to be foolish for the Lord and for what we proclaim not to come to pass in order that God might save the more? If not – it's time we made that decision. If we commit to be some coins in God's pocket, He can spend us or our reputation in any way, which contributes most to the kingdom.

#### WEDNESDAY, JUNE 19, 2024 Scripture: Jonah 4:6-11

God knows just how to get Jonah's attention, so He prepares a plant and causes it to grow, and it gives Jonah shade, and the plant becomes a "praise report" – for a day. But when the day passes a worm comes and kills the plant and it falls over. Now the plant that was a blessing looks cursed. It's dead. What do we see Jonah do? God knows exactly how to get the word across to Jonah. He has to be willing to pay the price to bring salvation - even if the price is the loss of his reputation. When we stand in the gap and stand on our covenant, we need to understand that mercy triumphs over judgement and we need to be willing to extend that mercy whatever the personal price. Moses came to a place he was willing for God to blot him out rather than lose the nation! He was personally invested and embraced the cross to the degree Jesus walked. You can't hang on to the covenant and not be willing to walk the crucifixion path. To stand on the platform of covenant where Moses and the prophets stood, impacting cities and nations – is to embrace the very same things they encountered. Are we really willing to walk that out? God is waiting ... for us.

#### THURSDAY, JUNE 20, 2024 Scripture: Genesis 18:16-26

One of the things we have to ask ourselves is what can one man do in covenant? Can one man persuade God? The clear testimony of Scripture consistently is that one man in covenant can persuade God! We see it first with Abraham, in Genesis 18, and the exciting thing is to look at God's response in the process. Verses 17- 19 reveal God's response to Abraham. The Lord says, "Shall I hide from Abraham what I am doing, since Abraham shall surely become a great and mighty nation, and all the nations of the earth shall be blessed in him? For I have known him, in order that he may command his children and his household after him, that they keep the way of the Lord, to do righteousness and justice, that the Lord may bring to Abraham what He has spoken to him." Abraham was the one who said, "...how can I know?" God responded

to Abraham's question with covenant. Now in verse 19 of chapter 18 we find the Lord says additionally that He established covenant with Abraham in order for him to walk out justice or judgment and righteousness in the earth. We find part of God's intent in covenant for you and me is to stand before Him in our generation concerning the cities and nations of our residence as priests to bring salvation and restoration. Abraham is the initial example of what interceding can do. <u>Can we persuade God? Yes – in covenant!</u>

#### FRIDAY, JUNE 21, 2024 Scripture: Exodus 32:9-14

We find examples of man persuading God throughout Scripture. In Genesis, with Abraham, the process is like discovery in intercession. Abraham obviously doesn't know his boundaries and approaches God much like he would bargaining for a piece of land. He starts out high and progressively moves lower. But in Exodus 32, with Moses, in a firmly established covenant we find much more boldness in verses 9-14. Moses stands before the Lord and pleads with God almost in an argumentative fashion and much more confrontational than Abraham ever was. Where has this boldness come from that possesses Moses in dealing with the One who has power over life and death.

Is the covenant deepening? Is it growing? Does Moses have a greater revelation of covenant than Abraham walked in?

- We've already answered the question: can one man persuade God.
- Now the question becomes: has Moses a greater revelation of covenant and is that the foundation of his boldness in approaching God. Look at what Moses says in verse 11,
- \* "Lord, why does Your wrath burn hot against Your people whom You have brought out of the land of Egypt with great power and with a mighty hand?"
- God had already said to Moses, in verse 7, "Go get down! For your people whom you brought out of the land of Egypt have corrupted themselves."
- Moses has no problem getting right back in God's face and saying, "Let's correct this they are not my people that I brought out. They are Your people that You brought out of the land of Egypt, with great power and with a mighty hand."
- ✤ Where does this confrontational boldness come from?
- I submit to you there is only one foundation for it.
- ✤ Abraham does not approach God in this way.
- Moses exercises a much firmer nose-to-nose relationship. It seems there can be only one answer and that answer is Moses has a firm grasp of the covenant and acts accordingly!
  A What do use have a grasp of?
  - A. What do we have a grasp of?
  - B. Do we have a grasp of going to church and warming a spot in our favourite pew?
  - C. What do we have a grasp of? It's time we got a firm grip on the covenant!

And I have put my words in thy mouth, and I have covered thee in the shadow of mine hand, that I may plant the heavens, and lay the foundations of the earth, and say unto Zion, Thou art my people. (Isaiah 51:15-16).

For any army to win a war, they will ensure their air-force is in place. Whether it is simple Calvary in ancient times, or soldiers positioned on the city walls, or on high hills or elevated places, these have the best view of the battle. For you to overcome the enemy in this spring season, ensure that the heavens are in agreement with you. Speak to the heavens over the month and ask them to declare the glory of Jehovah. Command the sun, moon, stars and every heavenly being to do Jehovah's bidding, and to do that which they were created for - to give Him pleasure (Ps 19:1-2, Rev 4:11)

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Once we acquire GOD's ordained knowledge for the heavens, we will be able to set up their dominion here on earth (Job 38:31-33). Remember that in Matthew 28:18-20 Jesus commissioned the fledgling Ecclesia with all the authority given to Him to go out into all nations and disciple them. This authority included that which is in heaven and on earth. It is our duty to answer in the affirmative, the question that Job was asked concerning the visible firmament in Job 38:31-33.

The Full Moon will occur June 22, at 01:08 UTC. Command the full moon to do its bidding and mark the seasons accurately as ordained in the beginning. (Psa 104:19-20, Psa 136:8) The moon is a faithful witness to covenantal promises, Ps 89:37. Pray that the moon will faithfully witness in the heavens the seasons of Jehovah's love, mercy, grace, power, 7 fold Spirits of the LORD, spiritual and physical healing and every covenant blessing the LORD has ordained for you, your family and kingdom citizens in your territory, Ps 65:11.

The full moon causes the ebb and flow of waters causing the tides to rise and fall. The earth is more than 70% water and so is the human body. The full moon influences the waters of the human body. That is why during the full moon the bodily and emotional responses are heightened and crimes of passion escalate. Pray that during the full moon, the moon will not strike you in an untoward manner, but it shall yield its best for you. Pray this for the Ecclesia and your territory.

In this season when the heavens speak of redemption preceding judgment, pray that those who are prone to worship of the moon will begin to sense the One who created the full moon and seek to worship Him – Jehovah.

SATURDAY, JUNE 22, 2024 Scripture: Numbers 20:9-12 The same man, who in Exodus 32:9-14 persuaded God to turn from judgment to mercy, now through anger and frustration in rebellion departs from what God told him to do and strikes the rock twice and then rebukes the people! He was only commanded to speak to the rock but instead struck it twice. The penalty seems severe in verse 12, "Because you did not believe Me, to hallow me in the eyes of the children of Israel, therefore you shall not bring this congregation into the land which I have given them." This, of course, is the famous water of Meribah – the place of strife. How is it that in one place Moses can turn God from judgment to mercy and in another place his own judgment of the people and lack of mercy now costs him going into the Promised Land! I guess our choice becomes one that has to be obvious – judgment or mercy. Don't ever choose judgment in the face of God's mercy! Moses did and it cost him going in. Isn't it time we got a grip on our covenant and began to extend the mercy of God?

# SUNDAY, JUNE 23, 2024 Scripture: Second Corinthians 3:1-6

The key of Second Corinthians 3:1-6 is the issue of sufficiency, "Not that we are sufficient of ourselves to think of anything as being from ourselves, but our sufficiency is from God, who also made us sufficient as ministers of the new covenant, not of the letter but of the Spirit; for the letter kills, but the Spirit gives life." What does it mean to be sufficient? The Greek word there is hik-an-o-o.

- o <u>It comes from hik-an-os which means to arrive competent after much elapsed time</u>.
- The concept means to gain power necessary to perform duties.
- So the issue of sufficiency is the issue of walking out God's process until we have arrived competent in the priestly call.
- That can only come through a full understanding of the covenant embracing the concepts, believing them, and standing up in them as if they were reality.
- Are we sufficient? The Bible says we have been made sufficient and the process to walk that out is the overcoming process of what stands before us encapsulated in the churches of Revelation 2 and 3 and the proclamation, "to him who overcomes...."

# MONDAY, JUNE 24, 2024 Scripture: Revelation 2:1,2; Second Corinthians 4:1-12

In each of the churches of Revelation the very same phrase appears. Each church is extended a special promise to those "who overcome". In the church of Ephesus, in Revelation 2:1-7, we're told in the last verse, he who overcomes "I will give to eat from the tree of life...." Very clearly the issue God had with each of the churches represented here was the issue of overcoming that with which they were faced. When we choose to overcome the adversity that stands against us in whatever area it is, we arrive sufficient to function in God's purpose and to birth His will in our generation for the city or nation in which we live. What did they have to overcome in Ephesus in order to arrive sufficient? Verse 4 says, "Nevertheless I have this against you, that you have left your first love." Ephesus, apparently from the historical accounts we have, was the pinnacle post apostolic church for a season. They had it all in Ephesus. Because they had it all – they had to overcome the issue of apathy. Is it not true that in our churches today – the Church pretty much has it all? And one of the major issues to overcome, is the issue of spiritual apathy! Truly many churches are much like Ephesus in all that God has given! Where do we stand in the overcoming category that we may stand before the Throne sufficient to turn judgment into victory?

# TUESDAY, JUNE 25, 2024

# Scripture: Revelation 2:8-11


For the church at Smyrna we are told at the end in verse 11, "He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. He who overcomes shall not be hurt by the second death." The issue of Smyrna was a rising persecution and tribulation even unto death. You can imagine in the face of imminent death many were probably thinking about recanting or moving away from Christianity. Is it possible that we will see persecution and tribulation of the magnitude that hit the church at Smyrna? I can guarantee it is coming! It is coming. Will we walk through it and stand sufficient when the time comes? Those choices need to be made now so the preparation can carry us through when it arrives. Are we prepared? Are we ready? Persecution is coming!

# WEDNESDAY, JUNE 26, 2024 Scripture: Revelation 2:12-17

Verse 17 says, "He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. To him who overcomes I will give some of the hidden manna to eat. And I will give him a white stone, and on the stone a new name written which no one knows except him who receives it." The interesting thing about the church of Pergamos is they have to deal with the doctrine of Balaam. So Pergamos represents any doctrine e.g. the spirit of mammon- a test as it comes to take us off track and remove us from the authority we need to walk sufficient in our covenant. These false doctrines have to be overcome has to be overcome! They were having difficulty with it in Pergamos. It became their test.

# THURSDAY, JUNE 27, 2024 Scripture: Revelation 2:18-29

Verse 26 says, "And he who overcomes, and keeps My works until the end, to him I will give power over the nations --." Verse 27 ads, "He shall rule them with a rod of iron; As the potter's vessels shall be broken to pieces – as I also have received from My Father;" The problem with the church at Thyatira is the issue of unsanctified mercy. They tolerated what God rejected and called abomination. They must have been easy- going and extended great mercy. The problem is they extended mercy to what God would never have touched. So the issue becomes one of discernment and only extending mercy and patience where God would. The judgment on Thyatira is perhaps the stiffest of all the churches. Perhaps in this process we see the heart of God and He will not tolerate many of the things that possibly are becoming common place in the Church. We must know if we are becoming more and more like Thyatira. <u>God would not tolerate it and they lost their sufficiency.</u> Will we walk out our sufficiency to the end? God is expecting us to.

The issue of perseverance and walking out God's salvation to the end is absolutely essential. If we are expecting the rapture and instead have to walk through persecution how many people will we lose because they were never prepared to face what suddenly materialises? Will God lay that at the feet of those of us who teach? It is time we pursued the Lord and His perseverance realizing there is a war to keep us out of the sufficiency necessary for our priesthood.

# SATURDAY, JUNE 29, 2024 Scripture: Revelation 3:7-13

At the church of Philadelphia we're told, "He who overcomes, I will make him a pillar in the temple of My God, and he shall go out no more. And I will write on him the name of My God and the name of the city of My God, the New Jerusalem, which comes down out of heaven from My God. And I will write on him My new name." The church at Philadelphia was the only one that was not rebuked for something. They were commended in all they did, keeping the commandments - persevering. They were promised an open door, yet still they were exhorted to be overcomers. Even when everything is going right we need to understand God still calls us to be overcomers. The church world has for many years been in what, to most,

seem like a Philadelphia atmosphere with nearly everything going well except for occasional moral leadership lapses. The hard truth is we have been much more like Laodecia than Philadelphia. Will the church wake up in time to make the necessary changes or will God have to do it for us?

# SUNDAY, JUNE 30, 2024 Scripture: Revelation 3:14-22


Perhaps the final church, Laodicea is much like churches in our modern economies of today – so given to wealth and finances that they don't really need God. Many have commented that we often see in spiritual fervency an inverse relationship between financial and spiritual success. <u>The greater the financial success – the less the spiritual fervency and consequently</u> <u>fulfilling God's plan. The church at Laodicea was full of people who had pride in all their accomplishments, because of all God had done for them financially.</u> In verse 21 we're told, "To him who overcomes I will grant to sit with Me on My throne, as I also overcame and sat down with My Father on His throne." Laodicea had reached the pinnacle of achievement in several areas –science and medicine was a major. They were also famous for the cloaks and their wool. Laodicea had a lot going for it, but in the process they had to overcome pride and arrogance because of the money and seeming success they enjoyed.

- 1. Where are we in that process?
- 2. Can we overcome? Can we gain our sufficiency (to be competent on arrival)


