

What is presented are not Jewish Dates or the Jewish calendar but what the LORD instituted which we all see manifested in the movement of the Moon every month. The enemy has always manipulated these bodies for which believers are just becoming aware. This season is also a special edition of revelation which brings a new breath of fresh air without adding to the word of God but confirms it and makes our faith stronger

You may wish to pray in two ways:-

1. You can pray using the whole journal to pray into the womb of time according to the authority level granted to you by your appointment in the Lord. Expect the prophetic germination [as you saturate the ground and the womb of time with God's ordination]

to happen. In any case ensure your seed remains in the ground as investment for the coming year. Determine, and command what this month should deliver to you and what it should not and must Not.

2. You can also use this daily for your prayers AND DEVOTION to prevail at the gate of each day, especially on critical days of intense warfare in the heavens. Remember that the day starts from 6pm for the next 24 hours. If you are in Britain for instance the time will be early hours of the next day in Hong Kong @ your 6pm.
3. This document may seem lengthy, but it shows the effort that was generated in prayer. You can keep it and save it for use in a good way.

Pray that your prophetic faculties will be on the rise and be enlarged and sharp...visions; dreams; interpreting symbols; applying parables; riddles; revelation and predictions; accurate delivery of words of wisdom and words of knowledge; intercessions; interaction with heaven etc.. Divine decrees to cause the future and many other such faculties.

SHAPE YOUR DAY, MONTH AND CONSEQUENTLY YOUR YEARS

Ignorance of what every month holds for you, your family, community, nation, the church and the continent at large has caused many to perish, miss out or not fully access what God has in store for them.

Understanding the heavens and what they signify every month is another very key aspect as we enter this new level of our assignments among the nations. While the kingdom of darkness has used astrology, prognostications, and all manner of demonic methods to control the activities on earth using the heavens, the church continues in ignorance. They have even employed materialism to blind believers in Jesus Christ, whereas **all things are yours**

We thank God for the many people whom He is raising in different parts of the world to understand what the heavens hold for us every month. As you seek deeper understanding, the Holy Spirit will guide you into greater revelations. Amen.

Praying as a Global Citizen: Awakening to God's Heart for the Nations.

Introduction

In today's interconnected world, where boundaries blur through technology, migration, commerce, and crises, the call to live and pray as a global citizen has never been more urgent or profound. Praying as a global citizen means interceding with a heart that carries the burdens, joys, and destinies of nations—not just one's own. It is about aligning with God's redemptive purposes across cultures, continents, and generations.

This message explores the biblical, practical, and prophetic dimensions of global prayer, encouraging believers to step beyond personal needs and enter the throne room of heaven with the mindset of kingdom ambassadors.

1. The Biblical Foundation: God Is a Global God

From Genesis to Revelation, Scripture paints a picture of a God whose eyes and heart are for all nations:

**“And in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed.” —
Genesis 12:3**

God's covenant with Abraham was never ethnocentric; it was always global in scope. Abraham's lineage was chosen to carry a blessing to every tribe and tongue. The prophets echoed this global desire:

**“My house shall be called a house of prayer for all nations.” —
Isaiah 56:7.**

Jesus reaffirmed this mission. His great commission wasn't to build local religious monuments—it was to disciple nations (Matthew 28:18–20). At Pentecost, the Spirit was poured out on a multilingual crowd, signalling the birth of a global Church. To pray as a global citizen is to return to the original intent of God's heart—nations living under His glory, reconciled through Christ, and worshiping in unity.

2. The Mindset Shift: From Local Survival to Global Intercession

Many believers pray with a survivalist mindset—focused solely on daily bread, protection, or personal promotion. While these prayers matter, they reflect an individualistic Christianity. However, Jesus modelled kingdom intercession, often withdrawing to pray, not for Himself, but for others—even weeping over cities (Luke 19:41–44).

To pray globally, we must shift:

- From self-preservation to kingdom advancement

- From individual breakthroughs to cultural transformation
- From “God bless me” to “God bless nations through me”

A global citizen in prayer thinks about:

- Persecuted believers in Iran or North Korea
- Revival among the youth in Europe
- Justice for refugees in Sudan
- Hope for the underground Church in China
- Salvation for unreached tribes in the Amazon
- Restoration for broken families in Chicago or Lagos
- The undocumented workers of the United States
- The killing of hundreds in Yelwata (Benue State, Nigeria) and the more than 3000 displaced persons.

This mindset grows as we study global news through God’s lens, learn about world cultures, and allow the Holy Spirit to break our hearts with what breaks His.

3. The Practice: How to Pray as a Global Citizen

a. Start with the Nations in Scripture

Begin by praying through passages like:

Psalms 2 – Declare God’s dominion over the nations.

Isaiah 60 – Call for the rising of global light and glory.

Revelation 7:9–10 – Envision and pray for the fulfilment of worship from every tribe and language.

David and others prophesied often in the Psalms about the whole earth experiencing salvation. These were prophecies about the kingdom. David, who was a king, prophesied often about the greater kingdom of his Seed, Christ, the Messiah. Some of those prophecies in the Book of Psalms are shown below:

- “You are My Son ... I will give You the nations for Your inheritance” (Ps. 2:7–8).
- “All the families of the nations shall worship before You” (Ps. 22:27).
- “The earth is the LORD’S” (Ps. 24:1).
- “According to Your name, O God, so is Your praise to the ends of the earth” (Ps. 48:10).
- “You who are the confidence of all the ends of the earth” (Ps. 65:5).
- “All nations whom You have made shall come and worship before you, O Lord” (Ps. 86:10).
- “The nations shall fear the name of the LORD, and all the kings of the earth Your glory” (Ps. 102:15).

- “Be exalted, O God, above the heavens, and Your glory above all the earth” (Ps. 108:5).

The vision of the prophets was always global. The kingdom would not be limited to Israel but would encompass all nations. The scribes and teachers understood this but did not understand how it would be accomplished. It would come through the death of the Messiah, the descent of the Holy Spirit and the preaching of the gospel

Let the Word shape your prayers, replacing anxiety with prophetic vision.

b. Use a World Prayer Calendar

Resources like Operation World, Joshua Project, or Joining Hanads to Pray offer daily prayer focuses on specific countries or people groups. This practice helps keep our prayers anchored in real-time needs.

c. Adopt a Nation in Prayer

As a family, church, or ministry, adopt tribes or countries. Learn its history, cultural pain points, spiritual strongholds, and redemptive potential. Pray weekly for its salvation, leadership, youth, church, and economy.

d. Engage in Prophetic Intercession

Ask God for dreams, visions, and burdens regarding global issues. Journal what He reveals. For example, He may show you an image of a flooded village in Southeast, Nigeria—prompting intercession for mercy, aid, and gospel access there.

e. Pray in Tongues for the Nations.

When you pray in the Spirit, the Holy Spirit helps you intercede beyond your language limitations (Romans 8:26–27). As you do, ask Him to target regions or people groups you know little about.

f. Fast for Global Revival.

Consider regular fasting—not just for personal growth—but for world transformation. Set aside days to pray for spiritual awakenings in regions suffering from spiritual drought or hostility to the gospel.

4. The Burden and the Joy of Global Prayer

Praying globally can be overwhelming—so much suffering, injustice, and darkness. But this burden is also a joy. Jesus carried the weight of the world in Gethsemane—not because He had to, but because love compelled Him. The same love compels us to pray for strangers we’ll never meet, trusting that our prayers participate in God’s redemptive actions.

When you pray globally:

- You begin to feel the heartbeat of God
- You grow in spiritual maturity and selflessness
- You experience the joy of partnering in missions without leaving your home

- You become aligned with heaven's agenda

5. Barriers to Praying Globally—and How to Overcome Them

a. Cultural Insularity.

We often see the world through the lens of our culture. This breeds indifference or misunderstanding. Overcome this by engaging with Christians from other nations, reading international Christian literature, or attending multicultural prayer events.

b. Prayer Fatigue

Global issues are vast and endless. Focus on a few key regions or themes, and trust others are covering other areas. Remember, you're part of a global prayer network.

c. Lack of Information

Use technology wisely. Follow reputable Christian news sources, mission updates, and intercessory platforms to stay informed.

d. Unbelief

Some doubt that prayer can impact distant lands. But Scripture and testimonies prove otherwise. One woman praying in Kansas can birth revival in Kazakhstan if God so wills.

6. Real-Life Stories: Global Prayer Works

a. The Moravians

In the 1700s, a small prayer community in Herrnhut, Germany, started a 24/7 prayer chain that lasted over 100 years. Their passion birthed one of the greatest mission movements of modern history. Today angels, still lingering are being assigned afresh by prayer warrior in the Moravian Falls.

b. Revival in the Hebrides

An old woman in her 80s, blind and housebound, prayed earnestly for God to move in the Hebrides Islands off Scotland. Her prayers, along with others, triggered a powerful revival in 1949.

c. Modern Testimonies

- During war in Ukraine, churches in Nigeria, Korea, and Brazil reported dreams and prayer burdens for safety, peace, and gospel access in Eastern Europe—many of which aligned with actual miracle reports.
- A Christian in India regularly prays for the Amazon. Years later, she met a missionary from Brazil who had experienced supernatural provision on a day she was specifically praying.

God uses our prayers to build bridges across time, unpenetrated communities and geography.

7. Prophetic Insight: Why Now?

The Holy Spirit is mobilizing a global prayer army in this generation. The signs are evident:

- Young people leading worship and intercession gatherings on college campuses.
- Multilingual Zoom prayer rooms uniting believers across continents.
- Movements like The Send, OneThing, and Global Day of Prayer mobilizing millions.

Why? Because the harvest is ripe, and prayer prepares the way. Before every outpouring of revival, there's an uprising of prayer. The shaking of nations demands prophetic intercession—not panic. We are not merely praying for the world to get better—we are laboring for God's kingdom to come in every language, region, and system.

8. The Endgame: A Worshiping Global Family.

Revelation 7:9 gives us the final picture: “A great multitude that no one could number, from every nation, from all tribes and peoples and languages, standing before the throne and before the Lamb...”

Praying as a global citizen is practice for eternity. Every intercession, every cry, every fast is a seed contributing to that glorious harvest. The ultimate outcome of global prayer is not just peace on earth—but a redeemed humanity enthroned in worship, forever.

Conclusion: Will You Take Your Place?

MISSIONS AND EVANGELISM INVOLVES:

Biblical Authority Over Serpents – Crushing the Enemy Beneath Your Feet

THEME: “Authority Over Serpents: From the Garden to the Cross”

A. Key Scriptures

- Genesis 3:15 – “He shall crush your head, and you shall bruise His heel.”
- Luke 10:19 – “I give you authority to trample on snakes...”
- Mark 16:17–18 – Believers “will pick up serpents... and it will not hurt them.”
- Acts 28:3–6 – Paul shakes off a viper and suffers no harm.
- Romans 16:20 – “The God of peace will soon crush Satan under your feet.”

B. Three Realms of Serpent Operation

1. **Garden-Level Deception (Genesis 3)**
 - *Serpents manipulate truth, plant doubt, and corrupt identity.*
 - **Your victory:** *Use the Word to shut down lies (Matthew 4:1–11).*
2. **Wilderness-Level Resistance (Exodus 7:10–12, Numbers 21:6)**
 - *Serpents fight your deliverance and try to stop movement.*
 - **Your victory:** *God turns rods into authority and bronze serpents into healing (John 3:14).*
3. **Infiltration-Level Attack (Acts 28:3–6)**
 - *Even in ministry or revival, serpents try to strike.*
 - **Your victory:** *Shake them off into the fire—don’t be delayed or paralyzed by their bite.*

C. Seven Dimensions of Authority Over Serpents in Christ

Dimension	What It Means	Scriptural Anchor
1. Delegated Power	You have Christ’s authority over darkness	Luke 10:19
2. Unharmful by Attacks	The enemy may try but cannot harm your destiny	Mark 16:18, Isaiah 54:17
3. Crushing Power	You don’t coexist with serpents—you crush them	Genesis 3:15
4. Supernatural Immunity	Poison cannot prevail when you walk in purpose	Acts 28:5
5. Fire Purging	Holy Spirit fire consumes serpent dwellings	Psalms 91:13, Isaiah 27:1
6. Territorial Recovery	You reclaim serpent-infested lands	Joshua 1:3, Numbers 33:52
7. Ancestral Redemption	Generational curses are broken by the blood of Christ	Galatians

D. Personal Reflection Questions

1. Where have I seen patterns of “serpent activity” in my family or land?
2. Have I taken spiritual authority to crush these patterns or tolerated them?
3. What does God want me to recover, protect, or transform for my lineage?

E. Action Points

- Daily declare Luke 10:19 and Romans 16:20.
- Apply anointing oil to your feet as a prophetic act of dominion.
- Intercede regularly over your family land and name.
- Host a family altar prayer or prophetic walk around your ancestral area.
- Teach younger family members about spiritual inheritance and authority.

Strategic Prayer Points

Strategic prayer points on “Crushing the Enemy Beneath Your Feet,” with scripture references integrated into each prayer for declaration, warfare, and alignment:

1. Delegated Power – Luke 10:19

Prayer Points:

- Father, I thank You for giving me authority to trample on serpents and scorpions. I walk in Christ’s dominion over all the power of the enemy!
- I declare that no satanic operation, agent, or system can override my delegated power in Christ.
- I activate divine boldness to exercise my spiritual authority without fear or hesitation.

2. Unharmed by Attacks – Mark 16:18, Isaiah 54:17

Prayer Points:

- I decree that no weapon formed against me shall prosper; every attack launched against my health, mind, ministry, or family is condemned.
- I nullify every satanic poison—spiritual, emotional, or physical—intended to derail my destiny.
- In the name of Jesus, I declare divine preservation and protection as I fulfill my purpose.

3. Crushing Power – Genesis 3:15

Prayer Points:

- I refuse to negotiate or tolerate serpents in my life—I crush them under my feet by the power of Christ.
- I enforce the verdict of Genesis 3:15 against every serpent spirit assigned to deceive, delay, or destroy my assignment.
- Father, empower me to detect and destroy hidden serpent agendas in my territory.

4. Supernatural Immunity – Acts 28:5

Prayer Points:

- Like Paul, I shake off every spiritual snake into the fire—no venom will hinder my progress.
- I decree supernatural immunity from demonic bites—visible or invisible, sudden or subtle.
- Let the purpose of God over my life neutralize every poison of betrayal, delay, or demonic manipulation.

5. Fire Purging – Psalm 91:13, Isaiah 27:1

Prayer Points:

- Holy Spirit, release your purging fire to consume every serpent nest and hiding place in my life and environment.
- I tread upon the lion, the adder, the young lion, and the dragon—I walk in fearless dominion.
- By the sword of the Lord, I strike down every serpent spirit in my dreams, home, and atmosphere.

6. Territorial Recovery – Joshua 1:3, Numbers 33:52

Prayer Points:

- I reclaim every inch of territory lost to demonic intrusion—spiritually, financially, emotionally, and relationally.
- I dispossess serpent spirits from my family, region, ministry, and calling.
- Father, wherever the soles of my feet step, I declare divine recovery and restoration.

7. Ancestral Redemption – Galatians 3:13-14

Prayer Points:

- I break every generational curse by the blood of Jesus—I stand in the finished work of Christ!
- By the power of redemption, I renounce all covenants with ancestral serpents and idols.
- I release my lineage, bloodline, and descendants from every demonic inheritance and declare generational freedom in Christ.

Experience has shown that if we just count on our love and passion to make inroads in the mission field or as pastors or in ministry, we'd likely become burnt out and quit very soon. Instead, God gave us the wisdom to prepare. The interest you expressed at the AWMC24, must remain burning and you have opportunity to be trained.

If you just show up in ministry, hearts full of love for God and eager to make big changes for His Kingdom, you will likely be back home early, burnt out and disappointed.

Instead, God gives us the wisdom to slow down and discover how we could effectively work on His behalf, using the talents, skills, and education He blessed us with.

God cut us out for this work, but we are presently rough and unpolished. **Fullstature College of the Bible and Missions (FCBM) will help take out the raw edges, sand out the splinters and prepared you for God to add the varnish, readying us to begin your work.** *Don't get us wrong we have always been a little unfinished, but God has helped us to help others since 1994. In this work, we will always need to be learning, growing, and adapting.*

The church could not be limited to Jerusalem. The Book of Acts is the story of the church and kingdom breaking out of the framework of the old covenant and breaking forth throughout the whole earth.

Adopt-A-Missionary- A Missions’ Strategy

...a strategy for loving the missionary family as well as the people groups, they serve

Adopt-A-Missionary is a mission strategy that has gained momentum in missions over the years. What makes this strategy different is its focus. Historically, churches have focused on countries, and mission agencies have focused their attention on people groups. Adopt-A-Missionary focuses *on missionary families, or what we can call message bearers.*

For 5 years, my wife (of blessed memory) and I served as missionary representatives to the Kenyan peoples of East Africa. We divided the nation of Kenya into 6. Working with the missionary on ground we had a plan to evangelise the nation. We raised teams of two by two from Nigeria and planted 6 churches throughout the country. In the last 29 years + the FMI missionary teams have been helped by God to open the gospel among 40 unreached people groups. Our FMC churches faithfully prayed and the missionaries that we served with, and the church has supported them financially.

In 1990 for example, we were relocated to Kano with two major tribes- the Kanawas and Magusawas. We were led of the Lord to pay more attention *to tribal missions in 1993, where the gospel has never been heard while maintaining a church base.* Thankfully, our churches have continued to pray for and support the mission’s effort with this strategic ministry.

ADOPT-A-Missionary Defined

What then does it mean to Adopt-A-missionary? It means committing yourself as an individual, fellowship group, local congregation, denomination, or mission agency to pray for and commit resources to win souls, establish believers, administrate the work within a specific people group through a missionary family or families. This commitment is continued until the believers in that people group can reach the rest of their people without outside (cross-cultural) assistance.

We are agents of God praying, giving, and serving to see an adopted family reach out to bring sinners into God's family. This is the true meaning of Adopting a missionary family. One day this will be accomplished, and every tribe, tongue, people, and nation will give glory to God around His throne (Rev. 5:9).

Adopt a Missionary Family

Fullstature Missions International is committed to the work of missions and has developed a ministry to bring into focus the Great Commission (Matt 28:19-20) set forth by Christ and to support missionary families need. We ask that your family prayerfully consider adopting a missionary family to be a blessing and to be blessed. After you have made an adoption, we encourage you can send your missionary family an email to share about your family and to ask them to share with you. The FMI becomes a bridge to help people you may never know or meet. You can reach out to the missionary during Holidays, birthdays, or anniversaries or just at any time. Commit to lift your missionary up in prayer. (Phil 6)

It is also our desire to support more missionaries through our ministry budget than we currently can do. The missionaries we support currently are under-supported. In other words, the support we grant is not adequate. In most cases, we are nearly able (with Naira) to provide what will keep body and soul together leaving projects in the field undone. This is where you pause and do something.

It is our goal to ensure that every Missionary, supported through, (what we call) the General Fund which includes the "Faith Promise Offering" (FPO), are missionaries we, as a ministry want to support.

The money these Missionaries receive is totally dependent on what is given by the individual or families who have adopted them.

Example: Missionary "Felix" may have two families in First Baptist Church which chose to adopt him. They do so for a combined support of \$200 per month, one for \$75 per month and one for \$125 per month. Should the family who chose to support Missionary "Felix" for \$125 per month be unable to do so for any reason, Missionary "Felix" would only receive \$75 for that month. There will be a "shortfall" and the family who was unable to give what they had purposed to give would not be contacted and asked, "Where is your contribution".

If you have a desire to support a Missionary, please feel free to fill out a "Adopt-A-Missionary Request Form" and return it to our ministry office.

Build a Relationship

Develop a relationship with your adopted missionary family. Learn about their ministry and their ups and downs so that you know when to Praise God with them and when to lift them up in prayer. Being a missionary can have very hard times and there is great comfort when a missionary knows that God is always there and that there are people supporting them at every step.

Faith Promise

In addition to your commitment to get to know and pray for your adopted missionary, you may consider supporting your missionary financially. Among some of the greatest difficulties that missionaries face is having their financial needs met. Missionaries typically spend a significant amount of time raising monies to support their ministries which in turn reduces the amount of time out in the field.







- Thank Him that He ordained that you will be made manifest on earth on a specific day in that month at a specific hour and minute.
- Thank Him that He has a purpose for your life, and it will be fulfilled.
- Ask Jehovah to forgive you where you have for one reason or another, ignored or rejected to recognize your day of birth.
- Thank Jehovah for the day of your conception. (Psa 139:13)
- Thank Jehovah that when He thought of you, he already thought of your entire life. Thank Him that He did not leave anything to chance. (Isa 49:1)
- Thank Him that he knew exactly what your redemptive purpose was going to be. (Psa. 139:16)
- Pray that He will reveal the original you more and more as you enter another year of your life. (Psa 139:13-15)
- Pray that He will restore the heavenly label, and the heavenly name He gave you before you were conceived. (Jer 1:5).
- Speak into the foundations of your life and prophesy good things.
- Prophecy that you will live and not die prematurely in any area of your life. Your family will live, the work of your hand will live and grow from strength to strength. Deut. 33:6, Psa. 27:13, 118:17
- Prophecy and proclaim the blessing of Levi upon your life as a priest unto Jehovah (2 Pet 2:9, Deut 33:8-11)
- Prophecy and proclaim the blessing of Benjamin upon your life Deut. 33:12
- Prophecy the blessing of the wisdom of Issachar in every area of life. Wisdom to establish the work of your hands, your family, as you grow a year older 1 Chron 12:32, Deut.33:18b-19, Pro 24:3-4
- Prophecy the blessing of Dan concerning your role as a leader. Prophecy over your inheritance that Jehovah will indeed ensure you leave an inheritance for your descendants. Deut 33:20-21, Psa 16:5-6.
- Prophecy the blessing of Joseph. Speak to the earth and declare that the earth will bring forth its best for you in this new year. Prophecy to the heavens to declare the glory of Jehovah over your life every day of this new year. Deut 33:13-17, Lev 26:4-5, Hos 2:21-22, Psalm 19:1-2, Isa 55:12
- Prophecy that you will grow in your spirit man into a matured son so you can receive your inheritance. Wherever you go in this new year, creation will experience release from frustration. Rom 8:19-20, Gal 4:1-2
- Praise Jehovah that your birthday marks the entry into another season of Jubilee. Thank Jehovah that immediately you were born, you cried out prophetically blowing your own jubilee cornet, and prophetically rejoiced in yourself. Ask Him to give you joy no matter your circumstance, to rejoice on this day. Amen.

The days and times highlighted in the month of August {below} are referred to as High Days on which to intensify intercession for yourself, family members, community, church and Nation. Men draw power from the celestial bodies and desire to invoke such powers against their fellow humans. You can disannul such powers by intensive intercession on these high days wherever you may be in the earth.

FRIDAY, AUGUST 1 – God’s Global Agenda Begins

Declaration: I manifest kingdom excellence as a global witness.


FRIDAY, AUGUST 8 – Prophets to the Nations.

Declaration: Every system shall bow to Jesus.






SATURDAY, AUGUST 30 – The Fullness of the Gentiles

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SUNDAY, AUGUST 31 - Groaning for the Nations

Romans 8:22–23 – “All creation groans...awaiting redemption.”

Creation itself cries out for the fulfilment of God’s redemptive plan. Earthquakes, injustice, and ecological collapse all signal the longing for restoration. But we, too, must groan—through deep intercession—for nations to be born again. This groaning is Spirit-led travail that births transformation. Revival doesn’t begin with applause but with tears. When we weep for cities, fast for nations, and plead for mercy, heaven responds. The Spirit helps us groan until His glory fills the earth.

Creation is waiting for your wisdom, and the gifts of God in you.

Prayer: I align with the intercession of the Spirit for the redemption of nations. Let my cry match heaven’s burden.

Declaration: I groan until nations are reborn in Christ.

GO “IN THE SPIRIT” by David Wilkerson

You can go “in the Spirit” to any nation on earth. You can touch an unreached people while on your knees. Indeed, your secret closet may become the headquarters for a movement of God’s Spirit over an entire nation.

I think of Abraham’s example. He prayed over godless, wicked Sodom. The Lord answered him, “If I find in Sodom fifty righteous within the city, then I will spare all the place for their sakes” (Genesis 18:26).

When Abraham heard this, he began to negotiate with the Lord. He asked, “(If) there shall lack five of the fifty righteous: wilt thou destroy all the city for lack of five?” (18:28). Abraham was asking, “Lord, what if there are forty-five righteous people among those fifty believers? What if only that many are praying seekers? Or, what if there are only ten upright people who seek you? If only ten call on you, will you spare the city?” God answered Abraham, “I will not destroy it for ten’s sake” (18:32).

This passage tells us something about the Lord. He is willing to save entire societies if he can find a band of righteous people within them. This speaks of people who seek his face for the sake of their nation.

God goes even further on this issue than he did with Abraham. In Ezekiel 22, God speaks of finding just one praying believer who will stand in the gap: “I sought for a man among them, that should make up the hedge and stand in the gap before me for the land, that I should not destroy it: but I found none” (Ezekiel 22:30).

At the time of Ezekiel’s prophecy, Israel was polluted spiritually. The prophets were profane, violating God’s law left and right. And the people were oppressed, vexed on all sides, full of lust, robbing one another. Not one person among them cried out to the Lord. Nobody stood in the gap to intercede. Yet God would have saved the entire nation for the sake of just one intercessor.


If you cannot physically go to the nations, you can be part of the support body of intercessors. And we are to assist those who have given themselves to go to the nations. When Paul writes of his journeys, he mentions not only Timothy and Titus as his helpers, but also Lydia and the other precious women who aided him. These were all devoted servants whose assistance helped touch entire nations with the gospel.
