Spiritual Training for Life's Challenges

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May the Lord grant you understanding of this prayer journal as you pray, consequent upon which there will be changes in your life or your prayer group or Family, Church, Nation, and Continent.

What is presented are not Jewish Dates or the Jewish calendar but what the LORD instituted which we all see manifested in the movement of the Moon every month. The enemy has always manipulated these bodies for which believers are just becoming aware. This season is also a special edition of revelation which brings a new breath of fresh air without adding to the word of God but confirms it and makes our faith stronger

You may wish to pray in two ways: -

1. You can pray using the whole journal to pray into the womb of time according to the authority level granted to you by your appointment in the Lord. Expect the prophetic germination [as you saturate the ground and the womb of time with God's ordination] to happen. In any case ensure your seed remains in the ground as investment for the coming year. Determine, and command what this month should deliver to you and what it should not and must Not.
2. You can also use this daily for your prayers AND DEVOTION to prevail at the gate of each day, especially on critical days of intense warfare in the heavens. Remember that the day starts from 6 pm for the next 24 hours. If you are in Britain for instance the time will be early hours of the next day in Hong Kong @ your 6pm.
3. This document may seem lengthy, but it shows the effort that was generated in prayer. You can keep it and save it for use in a good way.

Pray that your prophetic faculties will be on the rise and be enlarged and sharp...visions; dreams; interpreting symbols; applying parables; riddles; revelation and predictions; accurate delivery of words of wisdom and words of knowledge; intercessions; interaction with heaven etc.. Divine decrees to cause the future and many other such faculties.

SHAPE YOUR DAY, MONTH AND CONSEQUENTLY YOUR YEARS

Ignorance of what every month holds for you, your family, community, nation, the church and the continent at large has caused many to perish, miss out or not fully access what God has in store for them.

Understanding the heavens and what they signify every month is another very key aspect as we enter this new level of our assignments among the nations. While the kingdom of darkness has used astrology, prognostications, and all manner of demonic methods to control the activities on earth using the heavens, the church continues in ignorance. They have even employed materialism to blind believers in Jesus Christ, whereas *all things are yours*

We thank God for the many people whom He is raising in different parts of the world to understand what the heavens hold for us every month. As you seek deeper understanding, the Holy Spirit will guide you into greater revelations. Amen.

You Don't Outgrow the Word; You Outgrow Ignorance by the Word

Introduction

Faith is not a static possession but a living force that grows, weakens, or strengthens depending on its nourishment. As the Scripture declares: "So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God" (Romans 10:17). We cannot believe beyond what we actually know, and we cannot know beyond what we actually hear. Faith is never self-sustained—it is fuelled by God's word.

Many believers try to live on yesterday's revelation, but yesterday's bread cannot sustain today's battles. Just as the Israelites needed fresh manna daily, the Christian life requires continual feeding on God's word for faith to remain alive and effective. Regular gathering of God's children revival, miracle and healing services, Word expo-services, holiness conferences, or financial empowerment gatherings are not just events—they are spiritual fuelling stations where believers receive fresh doses of God's word.

From the lens of the fivefold ministry—apostolic, prophetic, evangelistic, pastoral, and teaching—let us explore how faith is nurtured and sustained, why continual feeding on the Word is non-negotiable, and how the church can live in perpetual victory over sin, sickness, poverty, ignorance, and death.

I. The Missionary/Apostolic Perspective: Establishing the Foundation of Continual Faith

Missionary work often takes place in spiritually hostile environments where unbelief, superstition, or false religion dominate. In such places, occasional exposure to truth is not enough. A missionary must continually proclaim Christ and feed the people with the Word until the seed of faith germinates and grows.

The apostolic calling carries a foundational grace (Ephesians 2:20). Apostles ensure that believers are grounded on Christ, the cornerstone, and built on a steady diet of God's word.

Just as farmers understand that one rainfall cannot sustain a crop, missionaries realize that one gospel message, no matter how powerful, cannot sustain a new believer. Faith must be fed regularly through teaching, preaching, and discipleship. Gatherings are not just for those in need but are preparatory doses for the spiritually strong. By attending when "things seem fine," believers receive reserves of truth to draw from when trials come.

Missionaries and doctrinal apostles do not only focus on conversion but also on cultivating faith communities where the Word is constantly heard. This guards against relapse into fear, poverty, or syncretism. The stronger the intake of God's Word, the stronger the believers will stand in freedom from sickness, sin, and ignorance.

1. Faith Cannot Survive on Memories

Scriptural Insight:

Peter reminds believers, *"I will not be negligent to remind you always of these things... though you know them and are established in the present truth"* (2 Peter 1:12–13). The apostolic call is to keep faith alive through fresh encounters with God's Word, not by living on yesterday's experiences. Jesus taught, *"Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God"* (Matthew 4:4). Notice: ***it's not what proceeded but what proceeds.***

Biblical Examples:

- **Israel in the Wilderness:** They had to gather manna daily (Exodus 16:15–21). Yesterday's manna bred worms; only fresh bread sustained them. This foreshadows the believer's need for daily revelation.
- **King Josiah's Revival:** Though Israel had memories of past glory, revival only came when the Book of the Law was rediscovered and read afresh (2 Kings 22:8–11).
- **Paul's Apostolic Pattern:** He prayed for the Ephesians not just to recall past blessings but that the eyes of their understanding be continually enlightened (Ephesians 1:17–18).

Ancient Practice: Early believers devoted themselves "to the apostles' doctrine, fellowship, the breaking of bread, and prayers" (Acts 2:42). Their strength was not in past memories of Pentecost but in continual engagement with truth.

2. The Architecture of Faith Communities.

Scriptural Insight:

Paul says, "Like a skilled master builder I laid a foundation, and someone else is building upon it" (1 Corinthians 3:10). Apostles are architects of communities where the Word flows as life, shaping people into disciples.

Biblical Examples:

- **Moses and the Tabernacle:** God gave Moses detailed blueprints on Sinai (Exodus 25:9). Every tribe's position, every article, and every priestly duty reflected divine order. Apostles today echo this principle by building communities around God's Word, not human ambition.
- **Ezra's Reforms:** After exile, Ezra established schools of the Law (Ezra 7:10; Nehemiah 8:8), ensuring the Word was central to Israel's restoration.

Paul's Training Centres: In Ephesus, Paul used the school of Tyrannus for daily teaching, and from there the Word spread across Asia (Acts 19:9–10). This is apostolic architecture: creating environments where the Word multiplies into leaders and movements.

Ancient Practice: Early Christians established catechumenate schools where new believers were systematically disciplined before baptism. This protected the purity of the faith and ensured a flow of reproducible leaders.

3. Guarding Against Substitutes

Scriptural Insight:

Paul warned: *"See to it that no one takes you captive by philosophy and empty deceit, according to human tradition... and not according to Christ"* (Colossians 2:8). True faith is not sustained by clever speech, but by the living Word: *"Faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God"* (Romans 10:17).

Biblical Examples:

- **Jeroboam's Golden Calves:** Instead of true worship in Jerusalem, he set up convenient substitutes in Bethel and Dan (1 Kings 12:28–30). Apostolic leaders warn against such replacements that dilute true faith.
- **Jesus vs. Pharisees:** The Pharisees clung to traditions of men, nullifying God's Word (Mark 7:13). Christ, the true apostle (Hebrews 3:1), restored focus to God's living truth.
- **Paul at Corinth:** He refused to build faith on eloquent wisdom but on the demonstration of the Spirit and power (1 Corinthians 2:4–5).

Ancient Practice: Apostolic fathers like Irenaeus (2nd century) warned against Gnosticism, which substituted mystical philosophies for the plain truth of Christ. Their defense was always: "Back to the Scriptures, back to the apostles' teaching."

Apostolic Application

- Churches should ensure apostolic teaching hubs where believers consistently hear the word in structured ways.
- Apostolic leadership must constantly stir up faith in new generations who were not there when the "25 years ago" move of God happened.
- Apostolic missions must export this truth across cultures, ensuring every nation drinks fresh water from the Word.

The apostolic ministry thus guards the foundation: without daily feeding on the Word, the church drifts into nostalgia rather than present-day faith.

II. The Word That Stirs Faith

The prophetic ministry carries the ability to breathe God's "now word" into the lives of believers. While apostles establish, prophets ignite.

Prophetic Insights

1. ***Faith Is Activated by Fresh Hearing*** – Prophets emphasize that what you hear today sharpens what you believe tomorrow. A word in season can dismantle unbelief and set hearts ablaze.
2. ***Overdose of the Word Is Impossible*** – Prophets declare boldly: "Eat the scroll, fill your belly" (Ezekiel 3:3). Unlike earthly medicine, you cannot overdose on God's Word. The more you take, the more alive you become.
3. ***Prophetic Atmospheres Stir Hunger*** – Prophets remind the church to attend healing services when healthy, financial seminars when not broke, and holiness messages when not under temptation. That is how the Spirit arms us ahead of crisis.

Prophetic Application

- Prophetic declarations during worship services must reawaken faith, not merely entertain emotions.
- Seasonal prophetic gatherings should be seen as preventive medicine: believers don't wait until crisis to receive.
- Prophets must continually confront unbelief, ignorance, and spiritual laziness with God's timely Word.

Prophetic ministry therefore ensures faith is not just doctrine but a burning conviction kept alive by God's voice.

III. Faith Comes by Hearing the Gospel

The evangelist carries the fire to proclaim the good news. At the heart of evangelism is the truth that people cannot believe until they hear (Romans 10:14–15).

Evangelistic Insights

1. ***Faith and the Gospel Are Inseparable*** – Evangelists highlight that saving faith is always birthed by hearing Christ preached. No one drifts into salvation without the gospel sound.
2. ***Beyond Conversion—Continual Nourishment*** – Evangelists remind us that it is not enough to believe once; we must keep drinking. Otherwise, the initial flame of salvation flickers out.
3. ***Freedom Through the Word*** – Evangelists emphasize testimonies: people freed from sickness, poverty, and sin when they continually expose themselves to gospel preaching.

Evangelistic Application

- Evangelistic crusades should not only call sinners to Christ but also strengthen and bring evangelistic impartation to believers with the ongoing Word.
- Evangelists must teach converts to remain in faith communities where hearing continues.
- Evangelistic discipleship material must stress Word-saturation as the key to lasting transformation.

For the evangelist, hearing is not a one-time event. The same gospel that saves is the gospel that sustains.

IV. Shepherding Believers into Consistent Feeding

Congregations are often tempted to live on the memory of past messages—what they “heard 27 years ago.” But truth fades when not refreshed. Just as manna spoiled if not gathered daily, so faith spoils if not continually fed. A pastor’s role is to ensure that the Word is not treated as rare medicine, but as daily bread. It is pastor’s prerogative to input all the construction specialist listed in Ephesians 4.

Pastors should encourage believers to attend gatherings not only in crisis but in times of strength. This creates a reservoir of faith to withstand sickness, temptation, or financial hardship and all emergencies. It also prevents the church from producing shallow believers who only seek God when in trouble. Instead, the church becomes a house of ongoing empowerment.

Furthermore, pastors must model continual feeding on the Word. Leaders who grow stagnant in their own study cannot ignite faith in others. A steady rhythm of scriptural teaching, worship, and testimony ensures that the congregation never runs short of “God’s dose” of truth. And in the kingdom, there is no overdose of His Word—the more you take, the freer you become. Pastors are shepherds who guide God’s flock into green pastures (Psalm 23:2). Their primary duty is to ensure believers are continually fed, protected, and healed.

Pastoral Insights

1. ***Faith Requires Daily Care*** – Pastors remind us that no believer matures on yesterday’s diet. Sheep must eat daily.
2. ***Safe Environments for Growth*** – Pastors stress the importance of attending word-based gatherings not only during crises but also when life seems calm. Prevention is better than cure.
3. ***Holistic Nourishment*** – Faith is not only for healing but also for holiness, ministry, finances, relationships, and overcoming temptation. Pastoral ministry ensures the Word is applied to all of life.

Pastoral Application

- Pastors should design Word-based routines: weekly Bible studies, small groups, and prayer meetings centered on Scripture.
- Pastors must counsel members to avoid spiritual starvation by substituting sermons with worldly philosophies.
- Pastoral ministry should model feeding: leaders who daily read and meditate on Scripture inspire their flock to do the same.

The pastoral heart ensures that believers are consistently nourished, never starving, never weak, but continually strong in faith.

V. Explaining How Faith Works

The teaching ministry has the unique grace to break down truths into understandable, applicable principles. *Teachers ensure believers know how faith comes, grows, and is maintained.*

Teaching Insights

1. ***Knowledge Sets Boundaries for Faith*** – Teachers clarify: you cannot believe beyond what you know. If you don't know it, you cannot claim it. Hence, ignorance is the greatest enemy of faith.

The teaching ministry thus secures the intellect and anchors the faith of believers in the unshakable Word.

Integration of the Fivefold

When the fivefold ministry functions together, believers experience holistic growth:

- Apostles lay the foundation of continual feeding.
- Prophets stir hunger with fresh words.
- Evangelists spread the gospel that births faith.

- Pastors nurture believers in safe environments of consistent feeding.
- Teachers explain, clarify, and structure truth for application.

Together they fulfill Ephesians 4:11–13—bringing the church into maturity, unity, and the fullness of Christ.

Practical Steps for Believers

1. ***Create a Daily Hearing Routine*** – Whether through Scripture reading, audio Bibles, or attending Word-filled gatherings, prioritize continual exposure.
2. ***Attend Word Gatherings Proactively*** – Don’t wait for crisis. Go to healing services when healthy; attend holiness conferences when not under temptation. This is spiritual immunization.
3. ***Overdose on the Word*** – Unlike medicine, the more of the Word you take, the stronger and freer you become.
4. ***Apply the Word Immediately*** – Don’t just hear. Do. Faith without works is dead (James 2:26).

Navigating The VAV Year (2025-2026)(5785–5786) In A PEY Season (2021-2029) (The Decade Of The Mouth).

(I humbly write as the Lord has given me light to show to the church on how we must **stake** our inheritance, ensuring promises don’t float away but remain fastened in our lives, families, on the missions’ fields, places of battle, ministries, and countries. We as God’s people must not shy away from **these dimensions of**

staking — Identity, Connection, Manifestation, and Transformation — anchor heaven’s promises into the earth, securing our covenant inheritance in Christ.

I will try and explain these in structured sections, **weaving together prophetic proclamation (seeing and declaring) and apostolic enforcement (governing and establishing).**

Prophetic and Apostolic Guide into a VAV Year (2026) in a PEY Season

Staking Our Inheritance Through Proclamation and Enforcement

Introduction: A VAV Year in a PEY Season

We are in the midst of a remarkable prophetic timeline. We have often stressed the nature of the writing of this journal. It is strategic as it guides into God’s Timeline so that **YOU CAN EXPERIENCE REDEMPTION LIFT**. ***If you pay attention, you push forward and breakout.*** The Hebraic calendar year 5786 is not just a number—it is a spiritual code pointing to times, seasons, and divine alignments. The decade of the PEY (80s) emphasizes the mouth, speech, and decrees. **We must not soon forget the COVID years as the enemy desired to shut our mouths. What we proclaim carries weight, shaping destinies, cities, and nations.**

But within this decade, the year 5786 draws out a particular letter: VAV (ו). ***VAV is the sixth letter of the Hebrew alphabet and functions as a nail, hook, or connector.*** It binds together what seems divided, joining heaven to earth, word to fulfilment, and spirit to matter. When PEY (mouth/declaration) and VAV (nail/connection) operate together, they create a kingdom dynamic of proclamation and enforcement. Amen.

This article will explore how to walk in prophetic and apostolic dimensions this year—prophesying God’s decrees (prophetic proclamation) and governing them into reality (apostolic enforcement).

Part One: Understanding the Times—Why PEY and VAV Matter

The PEY Decade (5780–5789)

- PEY means mouth: it is the decade of prophetic speech, decrees, and utterances (Proverbs 18:21).
- God is raising His people to *speak life over chaos*, to *frame futures by His Word*, and to *silence false voices that confuse nations*.

- The PEY season is about power in the mouth, but not just any speech—it is speech aligned with Heaven.

The VAV Year (5786)

- VAV means nail or hook. It is used in Hebrew grammar as “**and**”—a connector.
- Spiritually, VAV connects heaven and earth (Genesis 1 repeatedly says, “**And God said...** and it was so”).
- It is about staking inheritance—nailing down promises so they don’t drift away.

Together, PEY + VAV mean that this year is not about random speech but anchored decrees that bind heaven’s will to earth’s reality.

Part Two: Prophetic Proclamation—Speaking as Heaven Speaks

Prophecy begins with seeing and saying. This is the PEY dimension—what comes out of your mouth shapes the year ahead. But PEY in a VAV year means our words are not loose—they are nails that fasten destiny.

1. Identity: Standing in Christ the Son of Man

- **Scripture:** “*As He is, so are we in this world*” (1 John 4:17).
- **Proclamation:** I am not just a voice in the wind; I am one seated with Christ (Ephesians 2:6). My decrees give a voice to His authority.
- **Application:** When you declare healing, you speak as one joined to the Great Physician. When you decree resolutions to family issues, you speak as one joined to the Father of families in heaven.
- When you decree provision, you speak as one joined to the Lord of abundance.

Prophetic Insight: Many in this year will face identity challenges—*feeling small, powerless, poor, or unheard*. But God is saying: Your authority comes from union with Christ. Every decree you make in Him is a stake driven into the earth.

2. Connection: Heaven and Earth United

- **Scripture:** “Your kingdom come, Your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven” (Matt. 6:10).
- **Proclamation:** My words are not just prayers—they are bridges between heaven and earth.
- **Application:** When you pray for your family, tribes, ministry, or nation, see your words as the VAV—the connecting nail that brings heaven’s decree into earth’s condition.

Prophetic Insight: This is a year where prophetic decrees will collapse delays. What was “stuck in the heavens” is being nailed into earth’s soil. Amen.

3. Manifestation: Spiritual to Material

- **Scripture:** “Blessed be the God... who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing” (Eph. 1:3).
- **Proclamation:** Every unseen blessing must find expression. My inheritance will not remain locked in the invisible.
- **Application:** Begin to name your inheritance: Nations, land, health, finances, relationships, generational blessings. Speak as one pulling down the unseen into the seen.
- **We see an example in Numbers 21:16-18. There was no water. Israel sang: “Spring up O Well” that was a prophetic act calling what was hidden in the earth into manifestation. But there was an apostolic dimension in Num 21:18- that the princes dug the well by the direction of the lawgiver with their staves and the outcome was a well of water. We see authority and unity.**

Insight: For many, this year is a crossing point from prophetic promises into tangible possession. What your mouth decrees with faith will materialize as generational inheritance.

4. Transformation: From the Unseen to the Seen

- **Scripture:** “We look not at the things which are seen, but... at the things which are unseen” (2 Cor. 4:18).
- **Proclamation:** My home, city, and nation will look like heaven’s blueprint.
- **Application:** Do not speak what you see; speak what He shows. Align speech with heavenly reality until transformation occurs.

Insight: This is a year to shift atmospheres. The unseen will press into the visible. Expect radical changes in homes, churches, and even national policies as prophetic decrees take root.

Part Three: Apostolic Enforcement—Driving the Nails

Prophetic proclamation alone releases sound, but apostolic enforcement drives the nail deep until the word stands immovable. Apostolic enforcement is about government, order, and implementation.

1. The Apostolic Nature of VAV

- VAV is not a casual connector; it is a stake.
- Apostolic authority ensures promises are nailed down, not stolen.
- Without apostolic enforcement, prophetic words remain in the atmosphere.

2. Enforcing Identity

- **Enforcement:** Guard your identity in Christ. Do not let culture, fear, or failure redefine you.
- **Strategy:** Regularly declare: “I am seated with Christ. My authority is intact.”
- **Example:** Jesus in the wilderness (Luke 4) enforced His identity against satanic temptation by the Word.

3. Enforcing Connection

- **Enforcement:** Apostolic prayer brings heavenly blueprints into earthly systems.
- **Strategy:** Establish decrees through fasting, strategic intercession, and practical obedience.
- **Example:** Elijah decreed rain, but then he labored in prayer until the manifestation came (1 Kings 18).

4. Enforcing Manifestation

- **Enforcement:** Apostolic leaders build structures for spiritual blessings to land.
- **Strategy:** Create “buckets” for the rain—budgets, ministries, teams, systems—so when blessings come, they are contained.
- **Example:** Joseph not only interpreted Pharaoh’s dream but built grain houses to secure the harvest (Genesis 41).

5. Enforcing Transformation

- **Enforcement:** Apostolic governance shifts cities and nations (tribes).
- **Strategy:** Stake the land with prophetic actions, decree over institutions, and implement kingdom order in business, politics, and family.
- **Example:** Paul in Ephesus (Acts 19) not only preached but established a new spiritual economy that overturned idol worship.

Part Four: Practical Guide for the Year 5786

Luke 19:30–35 connects deeply with **pey** (mouth, declaration, prophetic release) and **vav** (hook, connection, apostolic enforcement into material reality).

1. Prophetic (Pey – Mouth/Declaration)

- Jesus gave a spoken prophetic instruction: “Go... you will find a colt tied... say, The Lord has need of him.”
- The word spoken ahead of time framed the reality. It was not yet seen, but the mouth (pey) released it into being.
- Prophetic declaration always identifies hidden resources (the colt was tied, unseen, restricted). The prophetic word brings it into visibility.

2. Apostolic (Vav – Connection/Enforcement)

- The disciples went and did exactly as instructed — this is apostolic obedience and enforcement.
- When challenged by the owners, the apostolic action held authority: “The Lord has need of him.” This simple phrase was both legal authorization and enforcement.
- The vav, as a hook, connects heaven’s decree (pey) with earthly manifestation. The colt was loosed and delivered to Christ — a material enforcement of a prophetic word.

Daily Practice

1. **Morning Proclamation (PEY):** Begin each day with decrees over identity, connection, manifestation, and transformation.
2. **Midday Enforcement (VAV):** Take practical action to anchor what you declared—phone calls, strategies, building, correcting.
3. **Evening Reflection:** Journal testimonies of manifestation and transformation.

Corporate Practice

- Churches and ministries should create Prophetic Proclamation Sheets for the year.
- Apostolic leaders should call enforcement gatherings to hammer words into place through fasting, intercession, and implementation.

National and Generational Application

- Nations: Stake territories with prophetic acts—plant scripture stakes, anoint gates, decree policies.
- Generations: Parents and mentors must declare over children and spiritual sons/daughters. Stake inheritance for future generations.

Conclusion: Living Anchored in a VAV Year

The year 5786 is not ordinary. It is a VAV year in a PEY season—a time when the mouth decrees and the nail secures. To walk faithfully:

- Proclaim prophetically what Heaven is saying.
- Enforce apostolically until manifestation comes.

WEAPONS OF THE COURT OF HEAVEN

AN OUTLINE

Declaration: The Lord will drop a miracle into someone's lap in Jesus Name.

Prophet Micaiah had access to heaven (see what is going on in heaven). 1 King 22:19 – "I saw the Lord" Be practical-

- PRAY * Open my eyes to see the Lord.

A matter has been brought before heaven's throne that is: -

- (1) A petition had come up and all the host of heaven were gathered.
- (2) V. 20 – it was the matter of Ahab.

I. THIS IS AN EXAMPLE OF "A COURT OF HEAVEN IN SESSION" 1 Kings 22:1-5.

V. 5 – the need to enquire for *the word of the Lord* before going to war – the promises, the prophecies – the gifts of the spirit operating.

V. 6-8 – the hatred of "that word" is the beginning of failure.

V. 9-16 – the drama of 400 prophets telling lies "*from the Lord*" but they had not visited the court of heaven. But Micaiah joined as he was told but the king of Israel suspected that Micaiah was not telling the truth. His prophecy at this time was not normal as the king had expected!

V. 17 – This is why you must pray for God to open your eyes.

V. 18 – The king of Israel being an evil king did not know that his case had already come before the court of heaven.

V. 19-20 – Ahab was to die, and he didn't know it!

V. 20 with V. 11-12- Behind the scenes in another realm, this was going on – therefore the ministry of a prophet is needed. There are problems that will not be solved without a prophet! And praise God this is not to find work for special people because the New Testament is a realm of the prophetic.

V. 22 – this was the end of Ahab before he died (v. 34-35). Please, note that **there is a court of heaven where judgement is given (this is an example of the court of heaven in session)**. Ps. 9:4

This is how to deal with pursuers that will not let you go, spirits or problems that will persist - you know how to go about it! V. 7 – there is a court room

Is. 41:21 -*How can you be going to prayer meeting or a service– woman of God, Pastor and your bag is not full of petitions with strong reasons.*

II. WRITE YOUR PETITION, COME AND PLEAD YOUR OWN CASE!

At the throne of God, we have a powerful weapon.

Example: Daniel 7:21 – They were holy but other powers were prevailing.

- There is a court room in heaven! Then V. 22, 26, 27. V. 26 – Judgement shall SIT. This is how to deal with big and small matters. The saints took their case to the court.

-

III. The court room of DARKNESS exists also. A court – is an assembly to discuss judicial matters – satanic agents. The devil and his agents' perfect methods to summon people's spirits out of their bodies and bring them to a satanic court - unwillingly. You may have a dream (which God allowed you to dream) and it is a reality. Many people ignore this to their peril. Satan counterfeits heaven. This is what he does. See the following examples:

Word of knowledge.

- I.** You see yourself in a court.
- II.** You dream and you see yourself in a police station – (Not a Joke)
- III.** If you also see a lawyer defending you in dream – the matter has been taken over by the Lord.
- IV.** Seeing yourself in handcuff or chains, means your character is been addressed and agents may soon arrest you.
- V.** If your spirit is summoned and you see yourself with dead people eating. Urgent action quickly!
- VI.** Seeing yourself among grey haired people dressed in black (old people) – you are among evil forces.

VII. If you see yourself wearing a lawyer's gown in a vision – God will use, you to deliver some people.

8. If you see yourself being accused by a lawyer pointing at you with accusation. You have entered God's court by a fast – Ps. 54. You may keep the watches 12, 3, 6, 9.

Prayer:

- “Every power summing my spirit to the satanic court, I shut you down. Your time is up! Enough is Enough!”

IV. YOU CAN DRAG SATANIC POWERS TO THIS COURT. Isaiah 6:1-4.

Satan does not like to be dragged to this court. Woe befall all enemies who are dragged to this court. You must **drag them to the court of heaven. God must judge.**

- Job. 23:2-5 – Job suffered in the center of a battle. Job brought his case. God restored Job.
- Luke 18:1-8 – God gives judgement in his court. Go there. Stop complaining that you don't have money! Or lack help! Go and apply for a grant, money, workers, office, a wife, husband, work etc.
- Long ago, I was out of the house for a workers' conference and one of my children became severely ill. On my return, my wife and I began to pray because at a point our baby was slumped over and breathless and there was no life in the child! We did not know it had to do with our house help. We started an intense intercession past midnight for 3 hours bringing our case to the court of heaven. And then something began to happen in our nanny's bedroom. She ran out repeatedly 3 times into the living room where we were praying. We asked her to sit down after the third incidence and explain why she running out of her bedroom? Then she explained that there was a “spirit gang” she belonged to, and those gangsters were beating her for coming to care for our baby! We won the battle and our child lived!

V. PREPARE TO PRESENT YOUR CASE

To get a hearing: -

(1) Be surrendered to the Lord -- Isaiah 6:1-4

(2) Give up all sins

(3) Need cleansing in your life. If you are a believer, Satan's legal claim on you has been removed. A woman had 7 graduate children, and all were jobless but after intense prayer, an old ragged man— meaning a poverty spirit walked out of her and then turned to look at her tummy (stomach) which had been tattooed with the image of a scorpion. (Heb. 10:19, 20-22.) The 7 graduate children found work.

- Every unconscious bondage allowing Satan access into my life – Be dismantled. Lord take and wash me with the blood of Jesus!



4. Organize the word (promises) for petition

- Strong reasons
- Write it like a petition.
- Show why do you need what you are asking for?

5. Come to the court room **BOLDLY**, Heb. 4:14-16; Eph. 2:18; 3:12. "This is how to enter the court room"

6. Request for Accelerated Hearing before the judge of the whole Earth! "I come in by the blood of Jesus"

7. Holy Spirit help me to order my case. We see one example about Korah, Datan and Abiram who did not know that Moses had made a special request for the type of death to be activated from heaven.

- Elijah brought fire on the prophets of Baal (850)
- Also see harassment of the apostle. Acts 4:23 -ff.

How To Present Your Case. See the example of the apostles: -

Acts 4 v. 24 - "Thou Art God" - These threats are not greater than you, O Lord. Lord, demonstrate your power!

1. Register as an attorney in the court of heaven.
2. Ask that your case receive divine preference.
3. Drag all enemies of your destiny to the court of heaven
4. Lord, avenge me of my adversaries
5. Bring Satan into that court room.
6. "Lord, place a **restraining order** on Satan now! I paralyzed his activity".
7. Do, to the enemies what you did in the case of Herod, Balaam etc. – no more curse in Jesus Name.

In 1 Kings 2:8-13; v. 17 – The matter came to be reported by the watchers! V. 18-25!

1 Kings 22:22 – When God is fighting you – you may run to a prophet or herbalist – a spirit will deceive those people and herbalists!

Heaven decided Ahab was to die. The soldier who shot him down did not aim at him! It was the king of Judah that these soldiers were pursuing but he cried to God, then a soldier fired a shot and the prophetic word moved the shot to kill Ahab! That is the result of the court of heaven's decision!

- If you have a court case, don't be afraid when a judgment is not given in your favor, the judges in the earth have no *locus standi* to disagree!
- You can apply to heaven and say a court has no jurisdiction in your case! For example you can file a request in marital matters if you are standing on holy ground that except your husband comes to beg you, his case should be dismissed with cost! Matt 19:1-9. You cannot cause me to commit adultery, this court has no jurisdiction!

All those who are bringing confusion into my marriage have no standing – they cannot pass this test in God's court. My in-laws or whoever is bringing cases against me have no legal capacity to institute proceedings in the court of heaven. They must be classified as :-

- Rebels, deserters
- Interlopers, adulterers
- Disorderly
- No standing
- Not title to sue
- No competence to initiate proceeding in the court of law

All **applicants, claimants, plaintiff, petitioners** or party must be disqualified on my case in Jesus Name. These people have not been, in anyway been adversely affected. There should be enforcement of my fundamental rights. Amen. These are examples of presenting cases in the court of heaven. I pray you win all your cases through your intercession!!



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Adopt-A-Missionary- A Missions' Strategy

...a strategy for loving the missionary family as well as the people groups, they serve

Adopt-A-Missionary is a mission strategy that has gained momentum in missions over the years. What makes this strategy different is its focus. Historically, churches have focused on countries, and mission agencies have focused their attention on people groups. Adopt-A-Missionary focuses ***on missionary families, or what we can call message bearers.***

For 5 years, my wife (of blessed memory) and I served as missionary representatives to the Kenyan peoples of East Africa. We divided the nation of Kenya into 6. Working with the missionary on ground we had a plan to evangelise the nation. We raised teams of two by two from Nigeria and travelled from Nigeria to the different regions of Kenya. We planted 6 churches throughout the country. In the last 29 years + the FMI missionary teams have been helped by God to open the gospel among 40 unreached people groups. Our FMC churches faithfully prayed and the missionaries that we served with, and the church has supported them financially.

In 1990 for example, we were relocated to Kano, Nigeria, Northwest, with two major tribes—the Kanawas and Magusawas. We were led of the Lord to pay more attention *to tribal missions in 1993, where the gospel has never been heard while maintaining a church base.* Thankfully, our churches have continued to pray for and support the mission’s effort with this strategic ministry.

ADOPT-A-Missionary Defined

What then does it mean to Adopt-A-missionary? It means committing yourself as an individual, fellowship group, local congregation, denomination, or mission agency to pray for and commit resources to win souls, establish believers, administrate the work within a specific people group through a missionary family or families. This commitment is continued until the believers in that people group can reach the rest of their people without outside (cross-cultural) assistance.

We are agents of God praying, giving, and serving to see an adopted family reach out to bring sinners into God’s family. This is the true meaning of Adopting a missionary family. One day this will be accomplished, and every tribe, tongue, people, and nation will give glory to God around His throne (Rev. 5:9).

Adopt a Missionary Family

Fullstature Missions International is committed to the work of missions and has developed a ministry to bring into focus the Great Commission (Matt 28:19-20) set forth by Christ and to support missionary families need. We ask that your family prayerfully consider adopting a missionary family to be a blessing and to be blessed. After you have made an adoption, we encourage you can send your missionary family an email to share about your family and to ask them to share with you. The FMI becomes a bridge to help people you may never know or meet. You can reach out to the missionary during Holidays, birthdays, or anniversaries or just at any time. Commit to lift your missionary up in prayer. (Phil 6)

It is also our desire to support more missionaries through our ministry budget than we currently can do. The missionaries we support currently are under-supported. In other words, the support we grant is not adequate. In most cases, we are nearly able (with Naira) to provide what will keep body and soul together leaving projects in the field undone. This is where you pause and do something.

It is our goal to ensure that every Missionary, supported through, (what we call) the General Fund which includes the “Faith Promise Offering” (FPO), are missionaries we, as a ministry want to support.

The money these Missionaries receive is totally dependent on what is given by the individual or families who have adopted them.

Example: Missionary “Felix” may have two families in First Baptist Church which chose to adopt him. They do so for a combined support of \$200 per month, one for \$75 per month and one for \$125 per month. Should the family who chose to support Missionary “Felix” for \$125 per month be unable to do so for any reason, Missionary “Felix” would only receive \$75 for that month. There will be a “shortfall” and the family who was unable to give what they had purposed to give would not be contacted and asked, “Where is your contribution”.

If you have a desire to support a Missionary, please feel free to fill out a “Adopt-A-Missionary Request Form” and return it to our ministry office.

Build a Relationship

Develop a relationship with your adopted missionary family. Learn about their ministry and their ups and downs so that you know when to Praise God with them and when to lift them up in prayer. Being a missionary can have very hard times and there is great comfort when a missionary knows that God is always there and that there are people supporting them at every step.

Faith Promise

In addition to your commitment to get to know and pray for your adopted missionary, you may consider supporting your missionary financially. Among some of the greatest difficulties that missionaries face is having their financial needs met. Missionaries typically spend a significant amount of time raising monies to support their ministries which in turn reduces the amount of time out in the field.


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- Thank Him that He has a purpose for your life, and it will be fulfilled.

WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 1

The Foundation of Discipline

Scripture: “He that hath no rule over his own spirit is like a city that is broken down, and without walls.” – Proverbs 25:28

Reflection: Discipline begins with mastering oneself. Without it, even great talents collapse. Discipline protects the soul like walls protect a city. It’s the inner strength to act without external proof.

Example: Joseph in Egypt resisted Potiphar’s wife when no one was watching (Genesis 39). Ancient Stoics also emphasized self-mastery above circumstances.

Application: Choose one area of your life today where you must “rule your spirit.” Practice self-control there.

THURSDAY, OCTOBER 2

Consistency: The Slow Builder

Scripture: “And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not.” – Galatians 6:9

Explanation: Consistency is doing the right thing long enough to see results. Results may delay, but faithfulness secures harvest. Each repeated act lays a foundation for future fruit.

Example: Noah built the ark over many decades despite no rain. Ancient builders in Egypt laid stones for years before pyramids were complete.

Application: Repeat one godly habit (prayer, study, kindness) daily this week without skipping.

FRIDAY, OCTOBER 3

Discipline Without Applause

Scripture: “But when thou doest alms, let not thy left hand know what thy right hand doeth.” – Matthew 6:3

Explanation: Discipline shines most when unseen. The unseen labor prepares the ground for visible glory. Growth happens in hidden seasons.

Example: David killed lions and bears privately before facing Goliath. Monks in the desert lived disciplined lives without crowds.

Application: Do one good act today with no expectation of recognition. Let God see it.

SATURDAY, OCTOBER 4

The Habit of Small Things

Scripture: “He that is faithful in that which is least is faithful also in much.” – Luke 16:10

Explanation: Consistency in small duties prepares us for greater ones. Greatness grows from repeated small habits. *Nothing entrusted to us is insignificant.*

Example: Elisha poured water on Elijah’s hands before inheriting his mantle. Roman soldiers practiced drills daily, preparing for battles.

Application: Identify a small habit (reading one chapter, writing one note, praying 10 minutes) and do it faithfully this week.

SUNDAY, OCTOBER 5

Discipline Resists Distractions

Scripture: “Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith.” – Hebrews 12:2

Explanation: Discipline requires focus. Distractions drain progress. Fixing eyes on Jesus keeps us steady on the path of destiny.

Example: Nehemiah refused to come down from building the wall despite opposition. Ancient marathon runners fixed their eyes on the finish line.

Application: Eliminate one distraction today (phone, gossip, idle talk) and channel that time into a discipline.

MONDAY, OCTOBER 6

Consistency Turns Weakness Into Strength

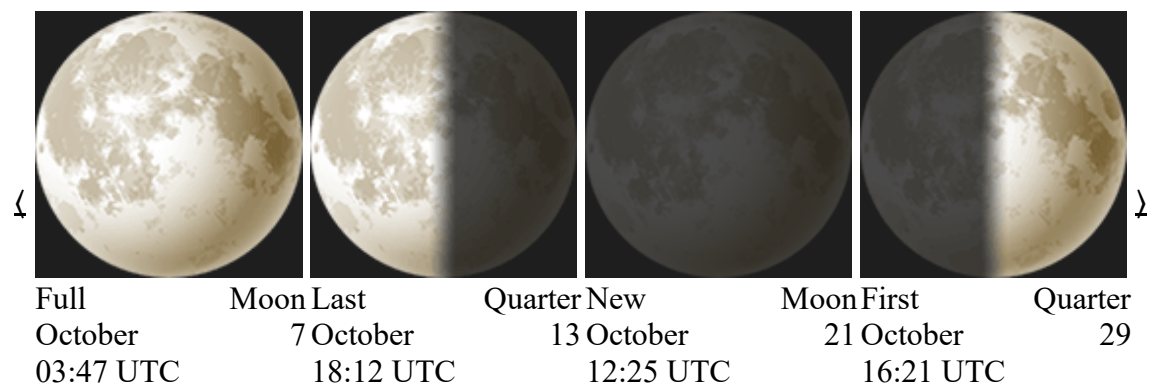
Scripture: “But I keep under my body, and bring it into subjection...” – 1 Corinthians 9:27

Explanation: Our natural weaknesses can be trained into strength through consistent discipline. What once ruled us can now serve us.

Example: Daniel disciplined himself with prayer three times daily in Babylon. Ancient archers improved accuracy only through repeated practice.

Application: Pick one area of weakness and set a small, consistent habit to master it this month.

TUESDAY, OCTOBER 7



The Reward of Steadfastness

Scripture: “Blessed is the man that endureth temptation: for when he is tried, he shall receive the crown of life.” – James 1:12.

Explanation: God rewards steadfastness. Consistency in trial proves faith and produces spiritual crowns. Reward may be delayed, but never denied.

Example: Job remained faithful despite trials and was doubly blessed. Ancient soldiers crowned victors after long campaigns, not short skirmishes.

Application: Remind yourself today that each act of endurance is building a crown. Write down one promise to hold on to.

WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 8

Discipline Creates Identity

Scripture: “But Daniel purposed in his heart that he would not defile himself...” – Daniel 1:8

Explanation: Discipline isn’t just about actions; it shapes identity. What we repeatedly refuse or embrace defines who we become.

Example: Daniel became known for prayer and purity. The Spartans were known for rigorous training and discipline.

Application: Declare today who you are becoming by discipline. Align your daily routine with that identity.

THURSDAY, OCTOBER 9

Consistency Breaks Barriers

Scripture: “By faith the walls of Jericho fell down, after they were compassed about seven days.” – Hebrews 11:30.

Explanation: Consistency in obedience breaks impossible barriers. Persistence in doing what God commands leads to breakthrough.

Example: Israel marched around Jericho daily until the wall fell. Ancient inventors tried hundreds of times before success.

Application: Identify one “wall” in your life. Commit to praying or working on it daily until breakthrough comes.

FRIDAY, OCTOBER 10

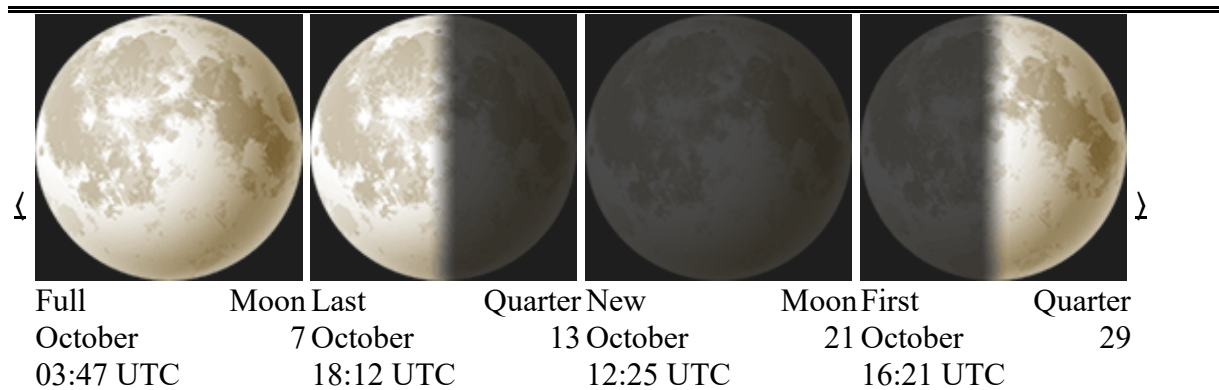
Both Sides of the Coin

Scripture: “Be ye steadfast, unmovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord...” – 1 Corinthians 15:58

Explanation: Discipline is the starting power; consistency is the staying power. Together, they guarantee growth and victory.

Example: Paul endured many trials but finished his race. Ancient scribes copied manuscripts daily, preserving truth through centuries.

Application: Write down one discipline to begin and one habit to continue. Pray for strength to have both.



SATURDAY, OCTOBER 11

Discipline in Speech

Scripture: “Let no corrupt communication proceed out of your mouth, but that which is good...” – Ephesians 4:29

Explanation: Words carry power. Discipline controls the tongue, preventing damage and cultivating edification. Controlled speech reflects a disciplined heart.

Example: Jesus remained silent before Pilate, choosing restraint over defense. Ancient philosophers trained orators to speak with precision and pause.

Application: Commit to speak three uplifting words today and avoid careless speech.

SUNDAY, OCTOBER 12

Consistency in Prayer

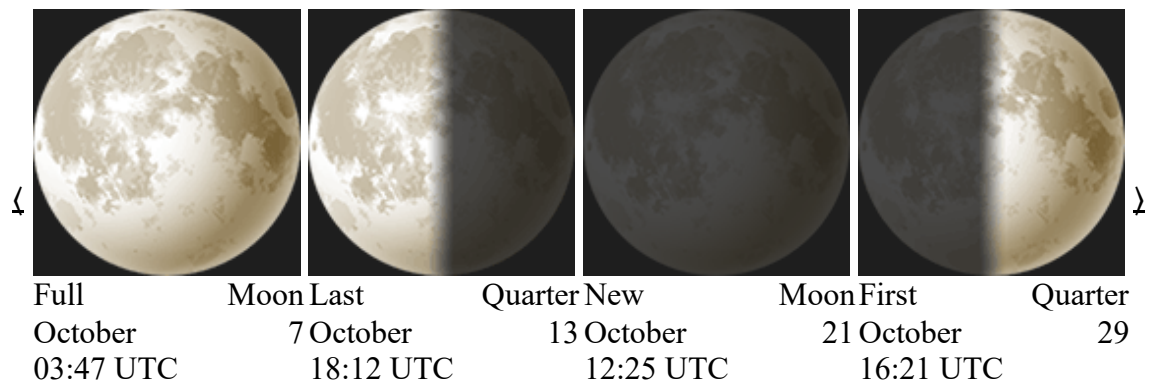
Scripture: “Pray without ceasing.” – 1 Thessalonians 5:17

Explanation: Consistency in prayer transforms weakness into strength. It creates intimacy with God and builds spiritual authority. Prayer is not occasional; it is continual.

Example: Daniel prayed three times daily despite opposition. Early church fathers scheduled hours of prayer, sustaining revival.

Application: Fix two prayer times today and keep them, no matter the interruptions.

MONDAY, OCTOBER 13



Discipline in Thoughts

Scripture: “Bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ.” – 2 Corinthians 10:5

Explanation: Discipline begins in the mind. A disciplined thought life prevents negative cycles and fosters faith-filled imagination.

Example: Joshua meditated on the law day and night. Ancient Stoics guarded thoughts against destructive passions.

Application: Replace one negative thought with a scripture promise today.

TUESDAY, OCTOBER 14

Consistency in Love

Scripture: “Charity never faileth.” – 1 Corinthians 13:8

Explanation: True love is not occasional but consistent. It remains steady in all seasons—when it’s easy and when it’s hard.

Example: Ruth stayed with Naomi consistently, even in hardship. Ancient covenant friendships endured despite trials.

Application: Show love today to someone who cannot repay you.

WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 15

Discipline in Finances

Scripture: “There is treasure to be desired and oil in the dwelling of the wise; but a foolish man spendeth it up.” – Proverbs 21:20

Explanation: Discipline in finances creates stability. Savings, stewardship, and wise use of resources honour God.

Example: Joseph stored grain during abundance for famine years. Ancient merchants prospered through disciplined trade and savings.

Application: Save or give intentionally today before spending.

THURSDAY, OCTOBER 16

Consistency in Work

Scripture: “And whatsoever ye do, do it heartily, as to the Lord, and not unto men.” – Colossians 3:23

Explanation: Consistency in work builds trust and excellence. When tasks are repeated faithfully, promotion follows.

Example: David tended sheep consistently before becoming king. Roman engineers built aqueducts over decades with precise diligence.

Application: Do one task today with extra faithfulness, even if unnoticed.

FRIDAY, OCTOBER 17

Discipline in Rest

Scripture: “And he said unto them, The sabbath was made for man, and not man for the sabbath.” – Mark 2:27

Explanation: Discipline includes resting. Without structured rest, productivity declines, and spiritual sensitivity weakens.

Example: God rested on the seventh day. Ancient farmers allowed fields to rest for greater harvest.

Application: Schedule rest moments today without guilt.

SATURDAY, OCTOBER 18

Consistency in Fellowship

Scripture: “Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together...” – Hebrews 10:25

Explanation: Consistency in gathering with believers strengthens faith. Isolation weakens, fellowship fortifies.

Example: The early church met daily in homes and temples. Ancient guilds thrived by constant gatherings.

Application: Attend or connect with one fellowship today, even briefly.

SUNDAY, OCTOBER 19

Discipline in Fasting

Scripture: “When ye fast, be not, as the hypocrites...” – Matthew 6:16

Explanation: Fasting disciplines the body and sharpens the spirit. It reorders desires and strengthens spiritual focus.

Example: Esther fasted before approaching the king. Ancient warriors fasted for strength and mental clarity.

Application: Skip one meal today and dedicate that time to prayer.

MONDAY, OCTOBER 20

Consistency in Scripture

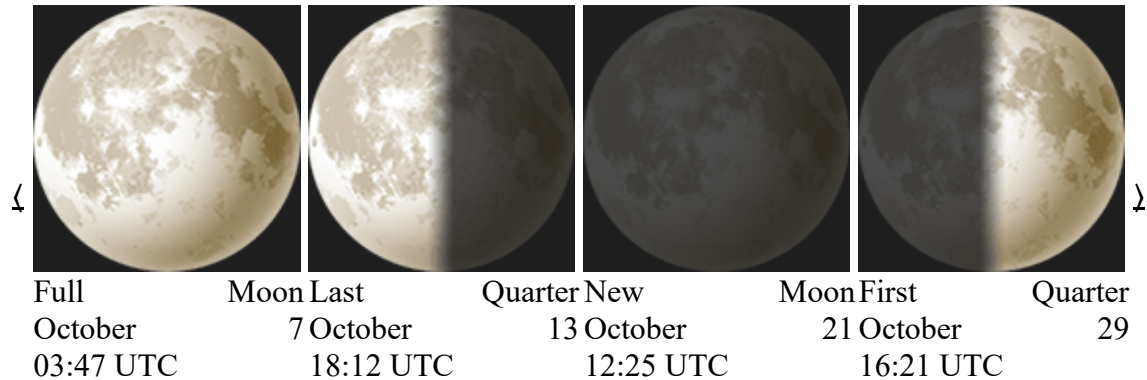
Scripture: “This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night.” – Joshua 1:8

Explanation: Scripture consistency brings prosperity and wisdom. Daily feeding of God’s Word transforms character.

Example: Ezra devoted himself to reading the law daily. Ancient scribes copied scriptures consistently, preserving truth.

Application: Read one chapter today and reflect on it three times during the day.

TUESDAY, OCTOBER 21.



Discipline in Giving

Scripture: “It is more blessed to give than to receive.” – Acts 20:35

Explanation: Discipline teaches sacrificial generosity. Giving trains the heart to trust God above resources.

Example: The widow gave her last meal to Elijah. Ancient communities shared resources during famine.

Application: Give something meaningful today—time, resource, or encouragement.

WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 22

Consistency in Integrity

Scripture: “The just man walketh in his integrity: his children are blessed after him.” – Proverbs 20:7

Explanation: Integrity must be consistent, not situational. Steadfast honesty builds generational blessings.

Example: Samuel’s integrity was unquestioned before Israel. Ancient magistrates who upheld justice consistently became trusted leaders.

Application: Tell the truth in one matter today, even if it costs you.

THURSDAY, OCTOBER 23

Discipline in Emotions

Scripture: “Be ye angry, and sin not.” – Ephesians 4:26

Explanation: Discipline governs emotions, preventing them from ruling decisions. Emotions are valid but must be harnessed.

Example: Moses lost the Promised Land due to uncontrolled anger. Ancient philosophers taught mastery of passions as wisdom.

Application: Pause before reacting emotionally today. Respond with prayer.

FRIDAY, OCTOBER 24

Consistency in Service

Scripture: “If any man serve me, let him follow me.” – John 12:26

Explanation: Consistency in serving others reflects Christ’s humility. Service builds strength of character.

Example: Jesus consistently served, washing disciples’ feet. Ancient rulers who served their people were remembered as noble.

Application: Serve someone today without seeking repayment.

SATURDAY, OCTOBER 25

Discipline in Waiting

Scripture: “They that wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength...” – Isaiah 40:31

Explanation: Waiting is active discipline. It tests patience and builds strength for soaring.

Example: Abraham waited 25 years for Isaac. Ancient farmers waited seasons for harvest.

Application: Wait patiently today for one answer without forcing it.

SUNDAY, OCTOBER 26

Consistency in Faith

Scripture: “For we walk by faith, not by sight.” – 2 Corinthians 5:7

Explanation: Faith must be consistent, not seasonal. Trust in God daily, not only in crisis.

Example: The woman with the issue of blood pressed through consistently until healed. Ancient sailors trusted stars daily for navigation.

Application: Declare faith in God for one area daily this week.

MONDAY, OCTOBER 27

Discipline in Correction

Scripture: “He that refuseth instruction despiseth his own soul.” – Proverbs 15:32

Explanation: Discipline embraces correction as growth, not rejection. Rebuke sharpens destiny.

Example: David accepted Nathan’s rebuke. Ancient apprentices grew under masters through correction.

Application: Receive one correction today with humility and gratitude.

TUESDAY, OCTOBER 28

Consistency in Testimony

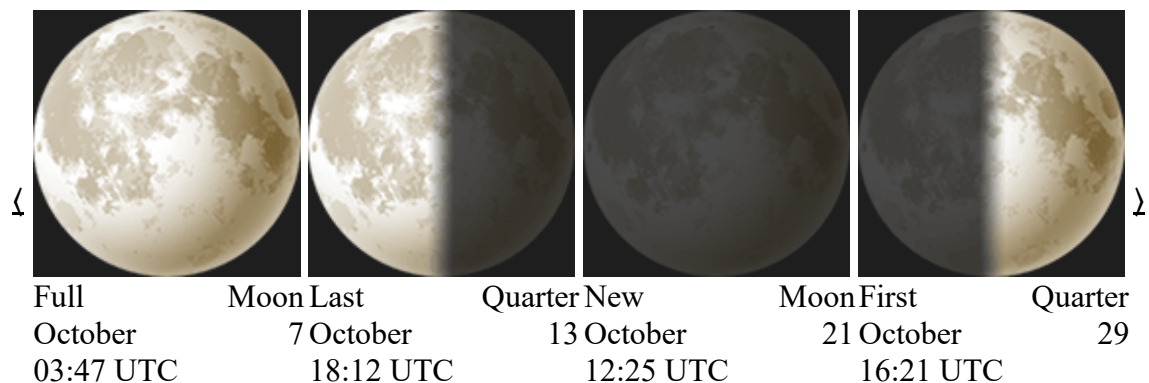
Scripture: “And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony.” – Revelation 12:11

Explanation: Consistently declaring God’s goodness strengthens faith and encourages others. Silence weakens, testimony empowers.

Example: Paul consistently testified before kings. Ancient historians preserved truths through repeated records.

Application: Share one testimony today with someone to inspire faith.

WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 29



Discipline in Sacrifice

Scripture: “Present your bodies a living sacrifice...” – Romans 12:1

Explanation: Discipline requires sacrifice—giving up comfort for God’s higher call. Sacrifice purifies devotion.

Example: Abraham offered Isaac. Ancient martyrs sacrificed lives for conviction.

Application: Give up one comfort today for spiritual growth.

THURSDAY, OCTOBER 30

Consistency Until the End

Scripture: “I have fought a good fight, I have finished my course, I have kept the faith.” – 2 Timothy 4:7

Explanation: The crown comes not for starting but for finishing. Consistency to the end secures eternal reward.

Example: Paul endured to his last breath. Ancient marathon runners gained glory only at the finish line.

Application: Renew your vow today: finish what you started with God.

FRIDAY, OCTOBER 31

Consistency in Praise

Scripture: “I will bless the Lord at all times; His praise shall continually be in my mouth.”
— Psalm 34:1

Explanation- Praise is not meant to be seasonal or circumstantial. True discipline in praise means choosing to honor and glorify God in both the highs and the lows of life. David, who penned Psalm 34, was not on a throne when he declared this — he was fleeing for his life. Yet he resolved to let God’s praise be constant on his lips.

Consistency in praise develops a spiritual posture that keeps the heart lifted above circumstances. It reorients focus from the problem to the greatness of God. When cultivated daily, praise strengthens faith, releases joy, and draws the presence of God (Psalm 22:3).

Example: Paul and Silas demonstrated this consistency in praise. In Acts 16:25, while imprisoned and chained, they prayed and sang hymns to God. Their consistency in praise was not dependent on comfort or freedom — and as they praised, God intervened with an earthquake that broke their chains and opened prison doors. Their testimony shows that consistent praise has the power to shift atmospheres and open impossible doors.

Application

- **Daily Practice:** Make praise a non-negotiable habit. Begin and end each day with words of thanksgiving and songs of worship, regardless of feelings.
- **In Challenges:** When tempted to complain, discipline yourself to replace negative words with praise. Say aloud, “Lord, I praise You because You are faithful,” even in confusing times.
- **Corporate Setting:** Encourage your family, prayer group, or church community to maintain a culture of consistent praise, not just during services but in everyday life.
- **Journal Prompt:** Write down three reasons to praise God today. Each day, add new ones. Over time, this list becomes a powerful record of God’s goodness and faithfulness.



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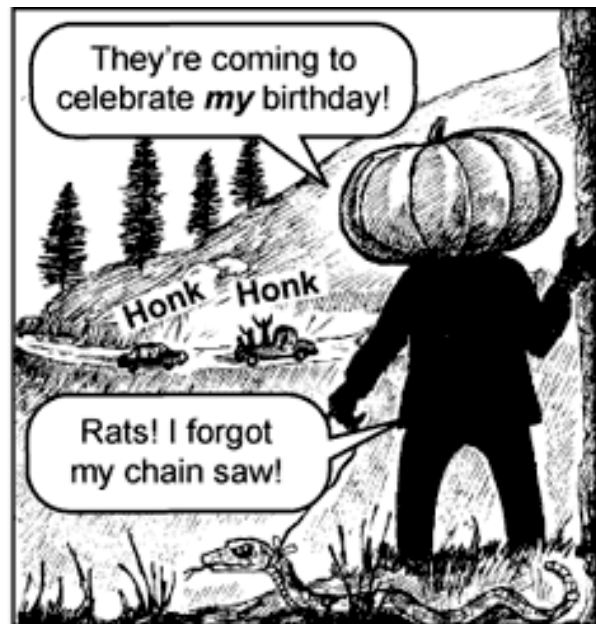


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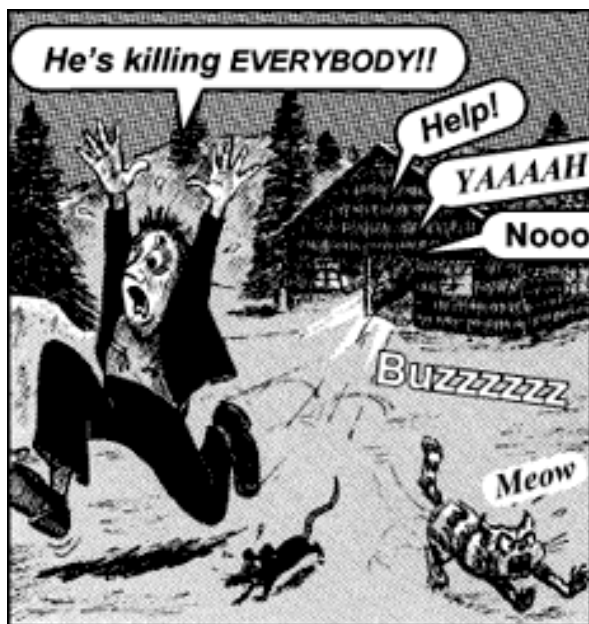


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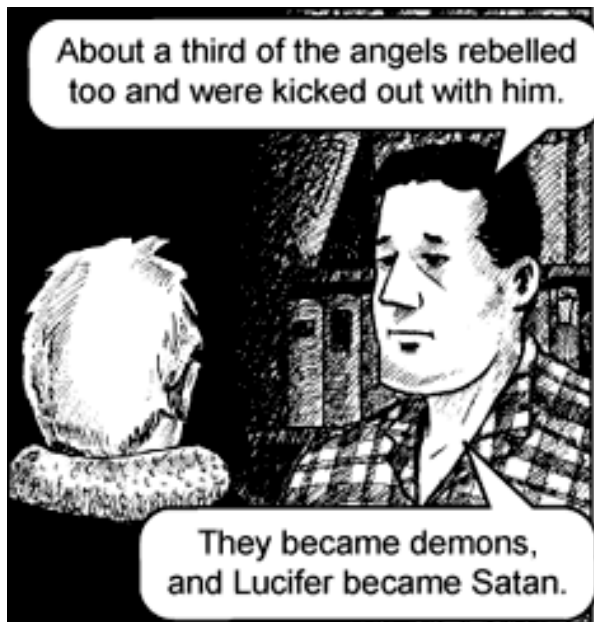
