You may wish to pray in two ways:-

- 1. You can pray using the whole journal to pray into the womb of time according to the authority level granted to you by your appointment in the Lord. Expect the prophetic germination [as you saturate the ground and the womb of time with God's ordination] to happen. In any case ensure your seed remains in the ground as investment for the coming year. Determine, and command what this month should deliver to you and what it should not and must Not.
- 2. You can also use this daily for your prayers AND DEVOTION to prevail at the gate of each day, especially on critical days of intense warfare in the heavens. Remember that the day starts from 6pm for the next 24 hours. If you are in Britain for instance the time will be early hours of the next day in Hong Kong @ your 6pm.
- 3. This document may seem lengthy, but it shows the effort that was generated in prayer. You can keep it and save it for use in a good way.

God's Word as Divine Messenger

Scriptures: Isaiah 55:11; John 1:1; Philippians 1:6

Introduction: The Word That Is Sent

Christian faith is not built merely on written texts, spoken sermons, or memorized verses. It is built on the Word of God as a living, active, and sent reality. From Genesis to Revelation, God does not simply speak—He sends. His Word travels. His Word acts. His Word accomplishes. His Word returns with evidence.

Isaiah 55:11 reveals one of the most profound truths in Scripture:

"So shall My word be that goes forth from My mouth; It shall not return to Me void, But it shall accomplish what I please, And it shall prosper in the thing for which I sent it."

This verse establishes a divine principle: God's Word is a messenger. It is dispatched with intention, authority, and a guaranteed outcome. The Word does not wander. It is not passive. It does not fail. It is sent, and it fulfills its assignment.

John 1:1 deepens this revelation:

"In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God."

Here, the Word is not merely speech—it is divine essence, personhood, and creative power. The Word is eternal, relational, and divine.

Philippians 1:6 then brings the truth home to the believer:

"Being confident of this very thing, that He who has begun a good work in you will complete it until the day of Jesus Christ."

God's Word does not only get sent into creation; it gets sent into people. And when the Word enters a person, it begins a work that cannot be abandoned halfway.

This article unveils a transformational truth:

God sends His Word, and then He sends us as carriers of that Word—to change every situation, every realm, and every circumstance: in heaven, on earth, and under the earth.

1. The Nature of God's Word: Living, Personal, and Powerful

God's Word is not ink on paper; it is life in motion.

Hebrews 4:12 declares:

"For the word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword..."

The Word is living—it has awareness, movement, and effect. It is powerful—it carries divine energy and authority. When God releases His Word, He releases Himself in action.

John 1:1 reveals that the Word is not just from God—it is God. This means:

- The Word carries God's nature
- The Word carries God's authority
- The Word carries God's presence

When God sends His Word, He sends His rule, His will, and His reality into a situation.

That is why creation responded instantly in Genesis 1. God did not negotiate with darkness, chaos, or disorder. He spoke, and the Word went forth as a divine messenger, rearranging reality.

2. The Word as a Sent Entity: Assignment, Purpose, and Return

Jesus walked as a Word on assignment:

- Wherever He went, atmospheres changed
- Wherever He spoke, reality shifted

Demons recognized Him because the Word carries authority in every realm. Sickness obeyed Him. Nature responded to Him. Death yielded to Him.

Jesus demonstrated that the Word is supreme over every realm—above the earth, on the earth, and under the earth.

4. The Word and the Three Realms of Dominion

Philippians 2:10 declares:

"That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth."

The Word of God has authority in three dimensions:

1. Above the Earth (Heavenly Realms)

The Word governs angels, spiritual order, and divine administration. Angels are described as those who:

"excel in strength, who do His word" (Psalm 103:20)

Angels respond to the Word because the Word establishes command.

2. On the Earth (Natural Realm)

The Word changes circumstances, nations, systems, families, and lives. When spoken in faith, the Word restructures visible reality.

3. Under the Earth (Spiritual Opposition)

The Word silences demons, breaks curses, and dismantles strongholds. Darkness has no defense against the Word sent by God.

5. The Word Sent Into Believers: God's Strategy for the Earth

Philippians 1:6 reveals that God begins a work in us. That work is initiated by His Word entering us.

James 1:21 says:

"Receive with meekness the implanted word, which is able to save your souls."

The Word is implanted, not merely heard. When the Word enters a believer:

- It rewrites identity
- It reshapes thinking
- It reprograms destiny

God does not only send His Word to us—He sends His Word into us so that He can send us into the world.

6. Believers as Sent Words

Jesus said in John 20:21:

"As the Father has sent Me, I also send you."

This is staggering. The same way God sent the Word made flesh, He now sends Word-filled believers.

Navigating The VAV Year (2025-2026) (5785-5786) In A PEY Season (2021-2029) (The Decade Of The Mouth).

(I humbly write as the Lord has given me light to show to the church on how we must <u>stake</u> our inheritance, ensuring promises don't float away but remain fastened in our lives, families, on the missions' fields, places of battle, ministries, and countries. We as God's people must not shy away from these dimensions of staking — Identity, Connection, Manifestation, and Transformation — anchor heaven's promises into the earth, securing our covenant inheritance in Christ.

I will try and explain these in structured sections, weaving together prophetic proclamation (seeing and declaring) and apostolic enforcement (governing and establishing).

Prophetic and Apostolic Guide into a VAV Year (2026) in a PEY Season

Staking Our Inheritance Through Proclamation and Enforcement

Introduction: A VAV Year in a PEY Season

We are in the midst of a remarkable prophetic timeline. We have often stressed the nature of the writing of this journal. It is strategic as it guides into God's Timeline so that YOU CAN EXPERIENCE REDEMPTION LIFT. *If you pay attention, you push forward and breakout*.

The Hebraic calendar year 5786 is not just a number—it is a spiritual code pointing to times, seasons, and divine alignments. The decade of the PEY (80s) emphasizes the mouth, speech, and decrees. We must not soon forget the COVID years as the enemy desired to shut our mouths. What we proclaim carries weight, shaping destinies, cities, and nations.

But within this decade, the year 5786 draws out a particular letter: VAV (1). *VAV is the sixth letter of the Hebrew alphabet and functions as a nail, hook, or connector*. It binds together what seems divided, joining heaven to earth, word to fulfilment, and spirit to matter. When PEY (mouth/declaration) and VAV (nail/connection) operate together, they create a kingdom dynamic of proclamation and enforcement. Amen.

This article will explore how to walk in prophetic and apostolic dimensions this year—prophesying God's decrees (prophetic proclamation) and governing them into reality (apostolic enforcement).

Part One: Understanding the Times—Why PEY and VAV Matter

The PEY Decade (5780–5789)

- PEY means mouth: it is the decade of prophetic speech, decrees, and utterances (Proverbs 18:21).
- God is raising His people to <u>speak life over chaos</u>, to <u>frame futures by His Word</u>, and to <u>silence false voices that confuse nations</u>.
- The PEY season is about power in the mouth, but not just any speech—it is speech aligned with Heaven.

The VAV Year (5786)

- VAV means nail or hook. It is used in Hebrew grammar as "and"—a connector.
- Spiritually, VAV connects heaven and earth (Genesis 1 repeatedly says, "And God said... and it was so").
- It is about <u>staking</u> inheritance—<u>nailing down promises so they don't drift away</u>.

Together, PEY + VAV mean that this year is not about random speech but anchored decrees that bind heaven's will to earth's reality.

Part Two: Prophetic Proclamation—Speaking as Heaven Speaks

Prophecy begins with seeing and saying. This is the PEY dimension—what comes out of your mouth shapes the year ahead. But PEY in a VAV year means our words are not loose—they are nails that fasten destiny.

1. Identity: Standing in Christ the Son of Man

• **Scripture:** "As He is, so are we in this world" (1 John 4:17).

- **Proclamation**: I am not just a voice in the wind; I am one seated with Christ (Ephesians 2:6). My decrees give a voice to His authority.
- **Application:** When you declare healing, you speak as one joined to the Great Physician. When you decree resolutions to family issues, you speak as one joined to the Father of families in heaven.
- When you decree provision, you speak as one joined to the Lord of abundance.

Prophetic Insight: Many in this year will face <u>identity</u> challenges—<u>feeling small, powerless</u>, <u>poor, or unheard</u>. But God is saying: Your authority comes from union with Christ. Every decree you make in Him is a stake driven into the earth.

2. Connection: Heaven and Earth United

- **Scripture**: "Your kingdom come, Your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven" (Matt. 6:10).
- **Proclamation:** My words are not just prayers—they are bridges between heaven and earth.
- **Application**: When you pray for your family, tribes, ministry, or nation, see your words as the VAV—the connecting nail that brings heaven's decree into earth's condition.

Prophetic Insight: This is a year where prophetic decrees will collapse delays. What was "stuck in the heavens" is being nailed into earth's soil. Amen.

3. Manifestation: Spiritual to Material

- **Scripture**: "Blessed be the God... who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing" (Eph. 1:3).
- **Proclamation**: Every unseen blessing must find expression. My inheritance will not remain locked in the invisible.
- **Application**: Begin to name your inheritance: Nations, land, health, finances, relationships, generational blessings. Speak as one pulling down the unseen into the seen
- We see an example in Numbers 21:16-18. There was no water. Israel sang: "Spring up O Well" that was a prophetic act calling what was hidden in the earth into manifestation. But there was an apostolic dimension in Num 21:18- that the princes dug the well by the direction of the lawgiver with their staves and the outcome was a well of water. We see authority and unity.

Insight: For many, this year is a crossing point from prophetic promises into tangible possession. What your mouth decrees with faith will materialize as generational inheritance.

4. Transformation: From the Unseen to the Seen

- **Scripture:** "We look not at the things which are seen, but... at the things which are unseen" (2 Cor. 4:18).
- **Proclamation**: My home, city, and nation will look like heaven's blueprint.
- **Application**: Do not speak what you see; speak what He shows. Align speech with heavenly reality until transformation occurs.

Insight: This is a year to shift atmospheres. The unseen will press into the visible. Expect radical changes in homes, churches, and even national policies as prophetic decrees take root.

Part Three: Apostolic Enforcement—Driving the Nails

Prophetic proclamation alone releases sound, but apostolic enforcement drives the nail deep until the word stands immovable. Apostolic enforcement is about government, order, and implementation.

1. The Apostolic Nature of VAV

- VAV is not a casual connector; it is a stake.
- Apostolic authority ensures promises are nailed down, not stolen.
- Without apostolic enforcement, prophetic words remain in the atmosphere.

2. Enforcing Identity

- **Enforcement:** Guard your identity in Christ. Do not let culture, fear, or failure redefine you.
- Strategy: Regularly declare: "I am seated with Christ. My authority is intact."
- **Example:** Jesus in the wilderness (Luke 4) enforced His identity against satanic temptation by the Word.

3. Enforcing Connection

- **Enforcement:** Apostolic prayer brings heavenly blueprints into earthly systems.
- Strategy: Establish decrees through fasting, strategic intercession, and practical obedience.
- **Example:** Elijah decreed rain, but then he labored in prayer until the manifestation came (1 Kings 18).

4. Enforcing Manifestation

- Enforcement: Apostolic leaders build structures for spiritual blessings to land.
- **Strategy:** Create "buckets" for the rain—budgets, ministries, teams, systems—so when blessings come, they are contained.
- **Example:** Joseph not only interpreted Pharaoh's dream but built grain houses to secure the harvest (Genesis 41).

5. Enforcing Transformation

- **Enforcement:** Apostolic governance shifts cities and nations (tribes).
- Strategy: Stake the land with prophetic actions, decree over institutions, and implement kingdom order in business, politics, and family.
- **Example:** Paul in Ephesus (Acts 19) not only preached but established a new spiritual economy that overturned idol worship.

Part Four: Practical Guide for the Year 5786

Luke 19:30–35 connects deeply with pey (mouth, declaration, prophetic release) and vav (hook, connection, apostolic enforcement into material reality).

1. Prophetic (Pey – Mouth/Declaration)

- Jesus gave a spoken prophetic instruction: "Go... you will find a colt tied... say, The Lord has need of him."
- The word spoken ahead of time framed the reality. It was not yet seen, but the mouth (pey) released it into being.
- Prophetic declaration always identifies hidden resources (the colt was tied, unseen, restricted). The prophetic word brings it into visibility.

2. Apostolic (Vav – Connection/Enforcement)

- The disciples went and did exactly as instructed this is apostolic obedience and enforcement.
- When challenged by the owners, the apostolic action held authority: "The Lord has need of him." This simple phrase was both legal authorization and enforcement.
- The vav, as a hook, connects heaven's decree (pey) with earthly manifestation. The colt was loosed and delivered to Christ a material enforcement of a prophetic word.

Daily Practice

- 1. Morning Proclamation (PEY): Begin each day with decrees over identity, connection, manifestation, and transformation.
- 2. Midday Enforcement (VAV): Take practical action to anchor what you declared—phone calls, strategies, building, correcting.
- 3. Evening Reflection: Journal testimonies of manifestation and transformation.

Corporate Practice

- Churches and ministries should create Prophetic Proclamation Sheets for the year.
- Apostolic leaders should call enforcement gatherings to hammer words into place through fasting, intercession, and implementation.

National and Generational Application

- Nations: Stake territories with prophetic acts—plant scripture stakes, anoint gates, decree policies.
- Generations: Parents and mentors must declare over children and spiritual sons/daughters. Stake inheritance for future generations.

Conclusion: Living Anchored in a VAV Year

The year 5786 is not ordinary. It is a VAV year in a PEY season—a time when the mouth decrees and the nail secures. To walk faithfully:

- Proclaim prophetically what Heaven is saying.
- Enforce apostolically until manifestation comes.

This is how we stake inheritance, ensuring promises don't float away but remain fastened in our lives, families, ministries, and nations.

Adopt-A-Missionary- A Missions' Strategy

...a strategy for loving the missionary family as well as the people groups, they serve

Adopt-A-Missionary is a mission strategy that has gained momentum in missions over the years. What makes this strategy different is its focus. Historically, churches have focused on countries, and mission agencies have focused their attention on people groups. Adopt-A-Missionary focuses on missionary families, or what we can call message bearers.

For 5 years, my wife (of blessed memory) and I served as missionary representatives to the Kenyan peoples of East Africa. We divided the nation of Kenya into 6. Working with the missionary on ground we had a plan to evangelise the nation. We raised teams of two by two from Nigeria and travelled from Nigeria to the different regions of Kenya. We planted 6 churches throughout the country. In the last 29 years + the FMI missionary teams have been helped by God to open the gospel among 40 unreached people groups. Our FMC churches faithfully prayed and the missionaries that we served with, and the church has supported them financially.

In 1990 for example, we were relocated to Kano, Nigeria, Northwest, with two major tribesthe Kanawas and Magusawas. We were led of the Lord to pay more attention to *tribal missions* in 1993, where the gospel has never been heard while maintaining a church base. Thankfully, our churches have continued to pray for and support the mission's effort with this strategic ministry.

ADOPT-A-Missionary Defined

What then does it mean to Adopt-A-missionary? It means committing yourself as an individual, fellowship group, local congregation, denomination, or mission agency to pray for and commit resources to win souls, establish believers, administrate the work within a specific people group through a missionary family or families. This commitment is continued until the believers in that people group can reach the rest of their people without outside (cross-cultural) assistance.

We are agents of God praying, giving, and serving to see an adopted family reach out to bring sinners into God's family. This is the true meaning of Adopting a missionary family. One day this will be accomplished, and every tribe, tongue, people, and nation will give glory to God around His throne (Rev. 5:9).

Adopt a Missionary Family

Fullstature Missions International is committed to the work of missions and has developed a ministry to bring into focus the Great Commission (Matt 28:19-20) set forth by Christ and to support missionary families need. We ask that your family prayerfully consider adopting a missionary family to be a blessing and to be blessed. After you have made an adoption, we encourage you can send your missionary family an email to share about your family and to ask them to share with you. The FMI becomes a bridge to help people you may never know or meet. You can reach out to the missionary during Holidays, birthdays, or anniversaries or just at any time. Commit to lift your missionary up in prayer. (Phil 6)

It is also our desire to support more missionaries through our ministry budget than we currently can do. The missionaries we support currently are under-supported. In other words, the support we grant is not adequate. In most cases, we are nearly able (with Naira) to provide what will keep body and soul together leaving projects in the field undone. This is where you pause and do something.

It is our goal to ensure that every Missionary, supported through, (what we call) the General Fund which includes the "Faith Promise Offering" (FPO), are missionaries we, as a ministry want to support.

The money these Missionaries receive is totally dependent on what is given by the individual or families who have adopted them.

Example: Missionary "Felix" may have two families in First Baptist Church which chose to adopt him. They do so for a combined support of \$200 per month, one for \$75 per month and one for \$125 per month. Should the family who chose to support Missionary "Felix" for \$125 per month be unable to do so for any reason, Missionary "Felix" would only receive \$75 for that month. There will be a "shortfall" and the family who was unable to give what they had purposed to give would not be contacted and asked, "Where is your contribution".

If you have a desire to support a Missionary, please feel free to fill out a "Adopt-A-Missionary Request Form" and return it to our ministry office.

Build a Relationship

Develop a relationship with your adopted missionary family. Learn about their ministry and their ups and downs so that you know when to Praise God with them and when to lift them up in prayer. Being a missionary can have very hard times and there is great comfort when a missionary knows that God is always there and that there are people supporting them at every step.

Faith Promise

In addition to your commitment to get to know and pray for your adopted missionary, you may consider supporting your missionary financially. Among some of the greatest difficulties that missionaries face is having their financial needs met. Missionaries typically spend a significant amount of time raising monies to support their ministries which in turn reduces the amount of time out in the field.

I declare that the Word of God is releasing healing and wholeness in my life. Every affliction bows to the authority of the Living Word. I receive strength, restoration, and divine health. I am made whole by His Word, in Jesus' name.

SUNDAY, JANUARY 25, 2026

Subtitle: The Word That Delivers From Bondage

Scripture: Isaiah 55:11; John 1:1; John 8:32

Reflections

Deliverance is the Word doing what it does best—setting captives free. John 8:32 declares that truth brings freedom. This means bondage survives where truth is absent, but collapses where truth is received. Isaiah 55:11 assures us that the Word will accomplish its mission, so deliverance is not a maybe—it is an assignment. John 1:1 reminds us that the Word is divine; therefore it breaks chains beyond human ability.

Bondage can take many forms: fear, addiction, shame, cycles, generational patterns, oppression, and mental prisons. But the Word enters like a divine messenger with authority to unlock doors. Deliverance is not only dramatic moments; it can also be progressive freedom as the Word renews the mind, uproots lies, and establishes truth.

Ancient Biblical Example

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Israel came out of Egypt by God's Word and God's power—captivity ended when God declared freedom.

Testimony

Someone trapped in fear began to speak God's promises daily. Over time, the grip of fear loosened until confidence replaced it completely.

Prayer

Father, send Your Word into every form of bondage in my life. Break every chain, uproot every pattern, and establish freedom in Christ.

Declaration

I declare that I am free indeed by the power of the Living Word. Every chain is broken—spiritual, emotional, mental, and physical. I step out of captivity into liberty. I live in truth, walk in freedom, and stand in dominion, in Jesus' name.



MONDAY, JANUARY 26, 2026

Subtitle: The Word That Releases Peace Beyond Understanding

Scripture: Isaiah 55:11; John 1:1; Philippians 4:7

Reflections

God's Word is a divine messenger of peace. Peace is not the absence of trouble; it is the presence of God governing the heart. Isaiah 55:11 assures us that the Word accomplishes what God intends—and God intends peace for His children. John 1:1 reveals the Word is God; therefore peace comes when the Word is received as God's presence in your situation.

Philippians 4:7 describes peace that surpasses understanding—meaning it is not logical, it is spiritual. When God's Word enters the heart, it quiets storms within even before storms outside change. The Word stabilizes the mind, calms anxiety, and establishes rest. Peace is the evidence that God is ruling inside you.

Ancient Biblical Example

Jesus spoke "Peace, be still" and calmed the storm—He also calms storms in hearts.

A believer facing uncertainty meditated on scripture nightly. Anxiety decreased, sleep returned, and peace reigned despite unanswered questions.

Prayer

TUESDAY, JANUARY 27, 2026

Subtitle: The Word That Brings Order Out of Chaos

Scripture: Isaiah 55:11; John 1:1; 1 Corinthians 14:33

Reflections

Chaos is not God's language—order is. 1 Corinthians 14:33 says God is not the author of confusion. When God's Word is sent, it brings structure, clarity, and divine arrangement. Isaiah 55:11 assures us the Word will prosper in its purpose—so disorder cannot remain where the Word is working. John 1:1 reveals the Word existed in the beginning; it is foundational and establishing.

If your life feels scattered, the Word can gather your thoughts, reorder your priorities, and realign your steps. God's Word brings inner order first—wisdom, discipline, discernment—then it produces outer order: organized outcomes, restored stability, and clear direction.

Ancient Biblical Example

In Genesis 1, the Word turned darkness and disorder into light and structure.

Someone overwhelmed by confusion began reading and confessing scripture daily. Clarity came, and wise decisions followed.

WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 28, 2026

Reflections

Fear of the future is often rooted in uncertainty, but God's Word is a divine messenger that brings assurance. Jeremiah 29:11 reveals God's plans are filled with hope and expected end. Isaiah 55:11 guarantees that the Word accomplishes its mission—so your future is not fragile; it is upheld by what God has spoken. John 1:1 confirms the Word is eternal, meaning it governs tomorrow as surely as it governed the beginning.

When the Word is received, it replaces dread with direction. It gives courage to plan, strength to wait, and faith to move. You are not walking into an unknown future—you are walking into a future God has already spoken about.

Ancient Biblical Example

God's Word guided Joseph from prison to palace—his future was secured by prophecy, not circumstance.

Testimony

Someone anxious about tomorrow found strength by declaring God's promises. Peace came, and doors opened gradually.

Prayer

THURSDAY, JANUARY 29, 2026

Subtitle: The Word That Produces Fruit and Maturity

Scripture: Isaiah 55:11; John 1:1; Colossians 1:10

Reflections

God's Word does not only give miracles—it builds maturity. It is a divine messenger that grows you. Colossians 1:10 speaks of bearing fruit in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God. Isaiah 55:11 shows the Word prospers in its purpose—one purpose is fruitfulness: character, wisdom, discipline, love, patience, and spiritual strength. John 1:1 reveals the Word is divine; therefore it produces divine nature in those who receive it.

Fruit takes time, but it is sure. As you stay in the Word, you are being shaped. Your responses change. Your desires align. Your endurance increases. People may not see the hidden work immediately, but the fruit will show—consistent, lasting, undeniable.

Ancient Biblical Example

Daniel grew in wisdom and favor because he stayed aligned with God's ways.

Testimony

A believer noticed growth over time—less anger, more patience, clearer discernment—evidence that the Word was maturing them.

Prayer

Father, let Your Word produce lasting fruit in my life. Grow me in wisdom, strength, and spiritual maturity.

Declaration

I declare that I am fruitful by the power of God's Word. I grow in wisdom, I grow in grace, I grow in discernment, and I mature in Christ. My life will produce lasting results that glorify God, in Jesus' name.

FRIDAY, JANUARY 30, 2026

Subtitle: The Word That Stands Forever

Scripture: Isaiah 55:11; John 1:1; Isaiah 40:8

Reflections

Everything in this world is subject to change—systems, people, seasons—but God's Word remains unshaken. Isaiah 40:8 declares that the Word of our God stands forever. Isaiah 55:11 assures us that what God speaks is not temporary; it accomplishes its purpose. John 1:1 reveals the Word is eternal—unchanging, unwavering, and fully reliable.

When life is uncertain, the Word becomes your anchor. When feelings fluctuate, the Word becomes your stability. When culture shifts, the Word remains truth. The permanence of God's Word means you can build your life on it without fear of collapse.

Ancient Biblical Example

God's covenant Word preserved Israel across generations despite captivity and opposition.

Testimony

A believer watched circumstances change repeatedly, yet God's promise remained steady—and eventually manifested.

Prayer

Lord, establish me on Your unchanging Word. Let me not be moved by seasons, but anchored in Your eternal truth.

Numbers 23:19 declares that God is not a man that He should lie. If He has spoken, He will do it. This is the confidence of believers: not that we are perfect, but that God is faithful. Sometimes the Word works quietly before it works loudly. Sometimes it rearranges unseen foundations before visible manifestations appear. But the end is sure: God's Word will complete its mission.

Ancient Biblical Example

Jesus—the Word made flesh—completed redemption fully and returned to the Father having finished the work.

Testimony

A believer looked back over a season and realized that what they prayed and declared in scripture gradually became reality—peace, provision, direction, and strength.





Declaration




We must think deeply about making Jesus known. He has given us the Holy Spirit, the Bible and many preachers but we need to be trained in our minds on how to be effective for the Lord.






<u>Unreached People by Region- Source: The Joshua Project, 2023</u> Definition

Unreached people groups are those who lack an indigenous church capable of evangelizing their own people. People groups are distinct social groups where shared language and cultural practices create communal belonging.


Missionary Challenge


