




May the Lord grant you understanding of this prayer journal as you pray, consequent upon which there will be changes in your life or your prayer group or Family, Church, Nation, and Continent. What is presented are not Jewish Dates or the Jewish calendar but what the LORD instituted which we all see manifested in the movement of the Moon every month. The enemy has always manipulated these bodies for which believers are just becoming aware. This season is also a special edition of revelation which brings a new breath of fresh air without adding to the word of God but confirms it and makes our faith stronger.

You may wish to pray in two ways:-

1. You can pray using the whole journal to pray into the womb of time according to the authority level granted to you by your appointment in the Lord. Expect the prophetic germination [as you saturate the ground and the womb of time with God's ordination] to happen. In any case ensure your seed remains in the ground as investment for the coming year. Determine, and command what this month should deliver to you and what it should not and must Not.
2. You can also use this daily for your prayers **AND DEVOTION** to prevail at the gate of each day, especially on critical days of intense warfare in the heavens. Remember that the day starts from 6pm for the next 24 hours. If you are in Britain for instance the time will be early hours of the next day in Hong Kong @ your 6pm.
3. This document may seem lengthy, but it shows the effort that was generated in prayer. You can keep it and save it for use in a good way.

Pray that your prophetic faculties will be on the rise and be enlarged and sharp...visions; dreams; interpreting symbols; applying parables; riddles; revelation and predictions; accurate delivery of words of wisdom and words of knowledge; intercessions; interaction with heaven etc.. Divine decrees to cause the future and many other such faculties

SHAPE YOUR DAY, MONTH AND CONSEQUENTLY YOUR YEARS

Ignorance of what every month holds for you, your family, community, nation, the church and the continent at large has caused many to perish, miss out or not fully access what God has in store for them.

Understanding the heavens and what they signify every month is another very key aspect as we enter this new level of our assignments among the nations. While the kingdom of darkness has used astrology, prognostications, and all manner of demonic methods to control the activities on earth using the heavens, the church continues in ignorance. They have even employed materialism to blind believers in Jesus Christ, whereas **all things are yours**

We thank God for the many people whom He is raising in different parts of the world to understand what the heavens hold for us every month. As you seek deeper understanding, the Holy Spirit will guide you into greater revelations. Amen.

WHEN JESUS CROSSED OVER FROM DEATH INTO LIFE — A PROPHETIC UNDERSTANDING FOR THIS SEASON.

(WHEN GOD RESETS TIME)

INTRODUCTION:

There are moments in Scripture when God does not merely intervene in circumstances—He redefines time itself. This is huge. One of the most powerful of these moments is found in Exodus 12:2, where God declares to Israel in the land of Egypt:

“This month shall be your beginning of months; it shall be the first month of the year to you.” This declaration did not come in a palace, nor in a season of ease, but in the midst of oppression, bondage, and systemic limitation. Israel was still physically in Egypt when God spoke. Yet heaven had already shifted their timeline. This is the mystery and power of the month of Nissan—a divine reset where God rewrites the narrative of His people from bondage to freedom, from death to life, from endings into beginnings.

Nissan is not merely a Jewish calendar marker; it is a prophetic portal embedded in Scripture, revealing how God moves His people through cycles of redemption. It contains within it the sequence of Passover, Unleavened Bread, and Firstfruits, all of which prophetically point to Jesus Christ—His death, burial, and resurrection.

Therefore, Nissan is not just historical—it is experiential. It calls every believer into a living encounter with the redemptive pattern of Christ:

- Death to sin
- Burial of the old
- Resurrection into new life

This is why believers must learn to discern spiritual timing. Because when God opens a window of transition, those who recognize it move forward; those who ignore it remain where they are.

THE DIVINE PATTERN OF TRANSITION — FROM DEATH TO RESURRECTION

1. THE NECESSITY OF CROSSING OVER

At the heart of Nissan is the concept of crossing over.

Israel crossed:

- The Red Sea (Exodus 14) — deliverance from bondage
- The Jordan River (Joshua 4–5) — entrance into inheritance

These crossings were not symbolic—they were defining transitions.

The Red Sea represents:

Leaving what held you captive

The Jordan represents:

Entering what God promised

Many believers experience a Red Sea moment—salvation, deliverance, breakthrough—but never step into their Jordan. They are saved, but not established. Delivered, but not positioned.

Why?

Because every crossing requires:

- Faith in uncertainty
- Obedience under pressure
- Movement before full understanding

God told the priests in Joshua 3 to step into a still-flowing river. The waters did not part until their feet touched the current. This reveals a critical prophetic truth:

God’s power meets us at the point of movement, not hesitation.

2. THE WAR AT TRANSITION: BREAKING LEVIATHAN

Every transition is contested. We identify the operation of Leviathan, a spiritual force characterized by twisting, confusion, pride, and resistance in the journey of the people of God.

Scripture confirms this:

- Isaiah 27:1 — God punishes Leviathan
- Psalm 74:14 — God crushes its heads
- Job 41 — describes its pride and strength

Leviathan does not always attack through obvious opposition. Often, it works subtly:

- Twisting communication between people
- Creating internal confusion
- Amplifying discouragement
- Producing spiritual fatigue

Its primary goal is to stop forward movement.

This is why many believers sense:

- Resistance when they are about to advance
- Confusion when clarity is needed
- Weariness when strength is required

But Scripture reveals that Leviathan is not invincible. It is defeated through:

- Repentance — aligning with truth (Luke 24:47)
- Praise — breaking spiritual resistance
- Truth — straightening what was twisted
- Authority in Christ — enforcing victory

When God parted the Red Sea, it was not just a miracle of water—it was a spiritual crushing of resistance. The same God is still active today.

3. PRAISE: THE WEAPON THAT GOES FIRST

Nissan is associated with the tribe of Judah, which means praise. Scripture repeatedly emphasizes:

“Judah shall go up first.” (Judges 1:2)

This is not a tribal arrangement—it is a spiritual strategy. I will enter His gates with thanksgiving in my heart I enter his courts with praise (Psalms 100:4).

Praise is a spiritual strategy before:

- Battles are won
- Doors are opened
- Chains are broken

Praise goes first.

We see this pattern throughout Scripture:

- Jehoshaphat sent singers ahead of the army (2 Chronicles 20)
- Paul and Silas praised in prison before deliverance (Acts 16)
- Israel shouted before Jericho's walls fell (Joshua 6)

Praise is not emotional expression—it is spiritual legislation. It establishes God's authority in a situation before the situation changes.

In a season like Nissan, praise is not optional—it is essential. It is the sound that:

- Precedes breakthrough
- Disarms opposition
- Aligns heaven and earth

4. PASSOVER: FROM DEATH TO LIFE

At the center of Nissan is Passover, the defining event of Israel's deliverance. In Exodus 12, a lamb was slain, and its blood was placed on the doorposts. When the angel of death passed through Egypt, it "passed over" every house marked by the blood.

This event prophetically points to Jesus Christ:

- John 1:29 — "Behold the Lamb of God..."
- 1 Corinthians 5:7 — "Christ our Passover was sacrificed for us"

Passover reveals a threefold pattern:

1. Death (The Lamb is slain)

Jesus died for sin. This represents the end of the old life.

2. Burial (Unleavened Bread)

Leaven represents sin and corruption. Its removal signifies purification and separation

3. Resurrection (Firstfruits)

Jesus rose as the firstfruits of a new creation life.

This pattern is not just theological—it is experiential.

Every believer must:

- Die to old patterns
- Bury former identities
- Rise into new life

THE CHRISTIAN CALL: DISCERNING TIMING IN TRANSITION

One of the greatest spiritual deficiencies among believers is not lack of faith—but lack of discernment of timing.

Jesus rebuked the Pharisees in Matthew 16:3 for not discerning “the signs of the times.” Similarly, many believers fail to recognize when God is:

- Ending a season
- Initiating a transition
- Opening a new dimension

Nissan teaches us that transitions follow a divine sequence:

1. Death Comes First

Something must end.

- Old mindsets
- Old cycles
- Old identities

If this is resisted, resurrection is delayed.

2. Burial Must Be Honored

There is a period where nothing seems to be happening.

Jesus was in the grave for three days. To human eyes, it looked like defeat. But in reality, it was divine processing.

Many believers abort their process because they misinterpret burial as abandonment.

3. Resurrection Requires Readiness

Resurrection is not automatic—it is entered into. Mary Magdalene recognized Jesus. Others did not. Why?

Because resurrection requires:

- Spiritual perception
- Alignment
- Expectation

4. Timing Determines Outcome

Ecclesiastes 3:1 reminds us:

“To everything there is a season...”

If you treat a burial season like a warfare season, you will strive unnecessarily. If you treat a resurrection season like a waiting season, you will miss opportunity. Discernment of timing is critical.

CONCLUSION: STEPPING INTO YOUR NISSAN MOMENT

Nissan is a divine invitation:

- To cross over
- To break resistance
- To embrace redemption
- To step into new beginnings

It is a season where God says:

“What held you will no longer define you.” “What ended is making room for what is beginning.”

But this invitation requires response. God parted the sea—but Israel had to walk through. God rolled away the stone—but someone had to enter the tomb.

PRACTICAL STRATEGIC PROPHETIC ACTIONS FOR THIS SEASON

1. Identify What Must Die

Ask the Holy Spirit:

- What mindset must I release?
- What cycle must end?

Write it down and consciously surrender it.

2. Honor the Burial Process

Do not rush what God is processing.

- Rest when needed
- Reflect deeply
- Resist panic

Trust that hidden seasons are not wasted seasons.

3. Engage in Intentional Praise

Daily:

- Praise before prayer
- Praise before decisions
- Praise before reactions

Let Judah go first.

4. Align Your Speech

Since Nissan is a month of speech:

- Eliminate negative declarations
- Speak life intentionally

Declare daily:

“I am crossing over into God’s new for my life.”

5. Expect Unusual Provision

Be open to:

- New opportunities
- Unconventional solutions
- Divine connections

God may change your supply system.

6. Take Bold Movement

Do not wait for perfect clarity.

Like the priests at Jordan:

- Step forward
- Act in faith

Movement activates miracles.

7. Make Prophetic Decrees

Each day, declare:

- ***“I enter my new season”***
- ***“Every resistance is broken”***
- ***“I walk in resurrection life”***

FINAL WORD

This is your Nissan moment.

Not just a time on a calendar—but a divine opportunity.

You are not stuck. You are not delayed.

You are not forgotten. You are in transition.

And if you align with God in this season, you will not just survive the shift—

You will emerge in resurrection power.

Adopt-A-Missionary- A Missions' Strategy

...a strategy for loving the missionary family as well as the people groups, they serve

Adopt-A-Missionary is a mission strategy that has gained momentum in missions over the years. What makes this strategy different is its focus. Historically, churches have focused on countries, and mission agencies have focused their attention on people groups. Adopt-A-Missionary focuses *on missionary families, or what we can call message bearers.*

For 5 years, my wife (of blessed memory) and I served as missionary representatives to the Kenyan peoples of East Africa. We divided the nation of Kenya into 6. Working with the missionary on ground we had a plan to evangelise the nation. We raised teams of two by two from Nigeria and travelled from Nigeria to the different regions of Kenya. We planted 6 churches throughout the country. In the last 29 years + the FMI missionary teams have been helped by God to open the gospel among 40 unreached people groups. Our FMC churches faithfully prayed and the missionaries that we served with, and the church has supported them financially.

In 1990 for example, we were relocated to Kano, Nigeria, Northwest, with two major tribes- the Kanawas and Magusawas. We were led of the Lord to pay more attention to *tribal missions in 1993, where the gospel has never been heard while maintaining a church base.* Thankfully, our churches have continued to pray for and support the mission's effort with this strategic ministry.

ADOPT-A-Missionary Defined

What then does it mean to Adopt-A-missionary? It means committing yourself as an individual, fellowship group, local congregation, denomination, or mission agency to pray for and commit resources to win souls, establish believers, administrate the work within a specific people group through a missionary family or families. This commitment is continued until the believers in that people group can reach the rest of their people without outside (cross-cultural) assistance.

We are agents of God praying, giving, and serving to see an adopted family reach out to bring sinners into God's family. This is the true meaning of Adopting a missionary family. One day this will be accomplished, and every tribe, tongue, people, and nation will give glory to God around His throne (Rev. 5:9).

Adopt a Missionary Family

Fullstature Missions International is committed to the work of missions and has developed a ministry to bring into focus the Great Commission (Matt 28:19-20) set forth by Christ and to support missionary families need. We ask that your family prayerfully consider adopting a missionary family to be a blessing and to be blessed. After you have made an adoption, we encourage you can send your missionary family an email to share about your family and to ask them to share with you. The FMI becomes a bridge to help people you may never know or meet. You can reach out to the missionary during Holidays, birthdays, or anniversaries or just at any time. Commit to lift your missionary up in prayer. (Phil 6)

It is also our desire to support more missionaries through our ministry budget than we currently can do. The missionaries we support currently are under-supported. In other words, the support we grant is not adequate. In most cases, we are nearly able (with Naira) to provide what will keep body and soul together leaving projects in the field undone. This is where you pause and do something.

It is our goal to ensure that every Missionary, supported through, (what we call) the General Fund which includes the “Faith Promise Offering” (FPO), are missionaries we, as a ministry want to support.

The money these Missionaries receive is totally dependent on what is given by the individual or families who have adopted them.

Example: Missionary “Felix” may have two families in First Baptist Church which chose to adopt him. They do so for a combined support of \$200 per month, one for \$75 per month and one for \$125 per month. Should the family who chose to support Missionary “Felix” for \$125 per month be unable to do so for any reason, Missionary “Felix” would only receive \$75 for that month. There will be a “shortfall” and the family who was unable to give what they had purposed to give would not be contacted and asked, “Where is your contribution”.

If you have a desire to support a Missionary, please feel free to fill out a “Adopt-A-Missionary Request Form” and return it to our ministry office.

Build a Relationship

Develop a relationship with your adopted missionary family. Learn about their ministry and their ups and downs so that you know when to Praise God with them and when to lift them up in prayer. Being a missionary can have very hard times and there is great comfort when a missionary knows that God is always there and that there are people supporting them at every step.

Faith Promise

In addition to your commitment to get to know and pray for your adopted missionary, you may consider supporting your missionary financially. Among some of the greatest difficulties that missionaries face is having their financial needs met. Missionaries typically spend a significant amount of time raising monies to support their ministries which in turn reduces the amount of time out in the field.

APRIL 1 — NISSAN 14

PASSOVER: THE BLOOD THAT BEGINS YOUR CROSSOVER

Reflection on Scripture

Passover is not symbolic—it is transactional. God did not negotiate Israel out of Egypt. He executed judgment and enforced deliverance by blood. The blood was not for decoration. It was for distinction.

In Nissan 14:

- bondage ends
- judgment passes over
- identity is sealed
- transition begins

This is where your “old life” legally ends. Before movement comes, there must be blood alignment.

Ancient Biblical Precedent

Israel was still in Egypt physically— but spiritually, they had already exited. Why? Because the blood spoke. Death visited Egypt, but it could not enter covenant-marked houses.

Testimony (Prophetic Pattern)

There are moments where:

- situations don’t change immediately
- environments remain hostile

Yet suddenly:

- destruction skips you
- tragedy avoids you
- judgment bypasses you

Not because of effort— but because of covenant.

Scripture

Exodus 12:12–13 (KJV)

“For I will pass through the land of Egypt this night, and will smite all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and against all the gods of Egypt I will execute judgment: I am the Lord.

And the blood shall be to you for a token upon the houses where ye are: and when I see the blood, I will pass over you, and the plague shall not be upon you to destroy you, when I smite the land of Egypt.”

1 Corinthians 5:7 (KJV)

“Purge out therefore the old leaven, that ye may be a new lump, as ye are unleavened. For even Christ our Passover is sacrificed for us.”

Prayer

Father, in the name of Jesus, I come under the covering of the blood. Let every judgment assigned to my life pass over me. Let the blood speak:

- deliverance
- protection
- exemption

Strategic Prayers

- Every generational pattern, break by the blood
- Every cycle of affliction, terminate now
- Let the blood mark my life for distinction

Prophetic Acts

Communion (Mandatory Today)

Take bread and wine intentionally:

“This is my covenant alignment. I step out of Egypt.”

Anointing Oil (Doorposts Act)

Lightly anoint your door and declare:

“No destruction enters here.”

Praise Pattern

Play worship songs about the blood (e.g., redemption, victory).

Declarations

- The blood speaks for me
- I am exempt from destruction
- My deliverance is activated

APRIL 2 — NISSAN 15 (DAY 2)

UNLEAVENED BREAD: PURGING THE OLD SYSTEM

Reflection on Scripture

Deliverance is instant. Transformation is a process.

Unleavened Bread is the removal of

- hidden sin
- old thinking
- toxic patterns
- internal Egypt

Leaven represents what spreads quietly. God is saying: “You cannot carry Egypt into Canaan.”

Ancient Biblical Precedent

Israel had to eat in haste— no time for fermentation. God was saying: “This is not a season to settle—it is a season to move.”

Testimony

Some people leave environments... but patterns follow them. This is where destinies stall. But when inner cleansing happens, acceleration begins.

Scripture

Exodus 12:15 (KJV)

“Seven days shall ye eat unleavened bread; even the first day ye shall put away leaven out of your houses...”

1 Corinthians 5:6–8 (KJV). “Know ye not that a little leaven leaveneth the whole lump? Purge out therefore the old leaven... Therefore, let us keep the feast... with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth.”

Prayer

Lord, search me deeply.

Remove what I cannot see.

Purge every hidden leaven.

Strategic Prayers

- I break agreement with old habits
- I reject internal bondage
- I align with truth and purity

Prophetic Acts.....Oil on Forehead

“Mind renewed. Thought patterns purified.” **Eat Plain Bread** (Symbolic)

Declare: “I walk in sincerity and truth.”

Praise Pattern: Slow worship—repentance, surrender.

Declarations

- I am being purified
- I release old systems
- I walk in truth

APRIL 3 — NISSAN 16 (DAY 3)

FIRSTFRUITS: ACTIVATING RESURRECTION AND HONORING GOD FIRST

Reflection on Scripture

Firstfruits is not about giving—it is about order.
Whatever comes first:

- determines what follows
- sanctifies the rest
- opens the future

Jesus rose on Firstfruits.

This means:

- **Resurrection Power Is Tied to Honour.**

In other words: Anything for your life wey don die—when you honour God e fit come back”....Honour na like key—if you use am well, e go open door for miracles...See eh...God no de force himself on anybody. If you respect Him, He go enter your matter, if you neglect or ignore Him na you sabi...”

Ancient Biblical Precedent

Israel brought the first harvest to God before touching the rest.

They trusted:

“If God receives first—He secures the rest.”

Testimony

People who honor God first:

- experience unusual preservation
- experience sustained provision

Scripture

Leviticus 23:10–11 (KJV)

“When ye be come into the land... then ye shall bring a sheaf of the firstfruits...

And he shall wave the sheaf before the Lord...”

1 Corinthians 15:20 (KJV)

“But now is Christ risen from the dead, and become the firstfruits of them that slept.”

Prayer

Father, I Honor You First.

Let Resurrection Power be Activated In My Life.

Strategic Prayers

- I break financial stagnation
- I activate covenant supply
- I align with divine order

Prophetic Acts

Firstfruits Giving (Seed)

Give something meaningful.

Oil on hands

“My work is blessed.”

Praise Pattern

Joyful, victory praise.

Declarations

- My future is secured
- Resurrection power is working in me
- My harvest is blessed


We must think deeply about making Jesus known. He has given us the Holy Spirit, the Bible and many preachers but we need to be trained in our minds on how to be effective for the Lord.




Unreached People by Region- Source: The Joshua Project, 2023

Unreached people groups are those who lack an indigenous church capable of evangelizing their own people. People groups are distinct social groups where shared language and cultural practices create communal belonging.


Missionary Challenge


